

NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER NO.3 2009

(PUBLIC FOOTPATH LA 19/75, COURT FARM, DUNDRY LANE, WINFORD)

The above Order, made on 24 July 2009, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert that part of public footpath LA 19/75 which runs from point A (Grid Reference ST 54470 65262) in a northerly direction for approximately 188 metres to point B on Dundry Lane (Grid Reference ST 54478 65449) as shown by a bold continuous line on the Order Map No. PPO 100 to a new route from point A (Grid Reference ST 54470 65262) running in a west, north westerly direction for approximately 132 metres to point C at which point it rejoins Dundry Lane (Grid Reference ST 54350 65315) as shown by bold broken line on the Order Map No. PPO 100. The proposed footpath is situated wholly within the Parish of Winford in the District of North Somerset and will have a width of 2 metres.

References to points A B and C above are references to the points on the Order Map no. PPO 100.

A copy of the Order and Order Map has been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Main Reception, Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare from 9:00am to 4:30pm Monday to Thursday (4.00pm Friday) or may be purchased there at the price of £6.00 (£6.50 if posted). A copy is also available for inspection at Reception in the Council Offices at Weston Court, Oldmixon Crescent, Weston-super-Mare (times as above) or at Winford Post Office and Stores, 11 High Street, Winford during normal opening hours (Monday to Friday 7.00am to 6.00pm, Saturday 8.00am to 6.00 pm and Sunday 8.00am to 1.00pm)

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Director of Development and Environment, Access Team, Weston Court, Oldmixon Crescent, Weston-super-Mare, BS24 9AU not later than **Friday 4 September 2009** (Quoting Reference MJB/PPO 100). Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Somerset District Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
