Frequently asked questions with answers for

Highway road markings

1. You have just resurfaced the road. Why have you not put back the markings?

Every effort is made to co-ordinate the white liners with the completion of the surfacing work and any delay is normally due to other work commitments or weather conditions. The lining is usually completed within a week of the completion of surfacing work.

2. Will you be reinstalling the cats eyes?

Where required. If they were previously installed they will be reinstalled. Additional cats-eyes may also be installed as required.

3. How long a time do you leave before re-marking?

This is site specific. There is no fixed time-scale but each location is taken on its own merit and a judgement made on the condition of the lining.

4. Why have you changed the markings that were originally there?

When carrying out maintenance works we assess the existing markings and if improvements can be accommodated we will endeavour to install them.
