PORTBURY)**

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER No. 1 2012

The above Order, made on 26th January 2012, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert those parts of Public Footpaths LA 15/4 and LA 15/5 in the Parish of Portbury within the District of North Somerset as described below, **from**:

that part of Public Footpath LA 15/4 in the Parish of Portbury from point A (Grid Reference ST 50484 75459) running in a generally east north easterly direction for approximately 87 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 50564 75492) then in a generally easterly then east south easterly direction for approximately 91.5 metres to point C (Grid Reference ST 50653 75483), then in a generally northerly direction for approximately 6 metres to point D (Grid Reference ST 50655 75488) and then in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 25.5 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST 50675 75473) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 145; and

that part of Public Footpath LA 15/5 in the Parish of Portbury from point F (Grid Reference ST 50613 75432) running in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 67.5 metres to point C (Grid Reference ST 50653 75483) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 145.

to:

a Public Footpath (LA 15/4) in the Parish of Portbury from point A (Grid Reference ST 50484 75459) running in an east north easterly direction for approximately 96 metres to a pedestrian gate at point G (Grid Reference ST 50579 75475), with a width of 2 metres, as shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 145; and

a Public Footpath (LA 15/5) in the Parish of Portbury running from point F (Grid Reference ST 50613 75432) running in a generally northerly then north westerly direction for approximately 57.5 metres to point G (Grid Ref. ST 50579 75475), with a width of 2 metres, as shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 145.

A new BS 5709.2006 compliant pedestrian gate will replace the existing stile at point G. References to points A, B, C, D, E, F and G above are references to the points on the Order Map No. PPO 145.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Director of Development and Environment, Natural Environment Team, Streets and Open Spaces, North Somerset Council, Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, BS23 1UJ not later than **1st March 2012** (quoting reference **PAP/PPO 145**). Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Somerset District Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER NO. 1 2012

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council (“the authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of the Order and of the public it is expedient that the lines of the paths should be diverted.

The applicants have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the paths into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land situated south west of the M5 Junction 19, Portbury and shown by bold continuous lines on the Map No. PPO 145 contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which North Somerset District Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highways mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be public footpaths over the land situated south west of the M5 Junction 19, Portbury described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken lines on the Map No. PPO 145 contained in this Order.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

Public Footpath LA 15/4

That part of Public Footpath LA 15/4 in the Parish of Portbury from point A (Grid Reference ST 50484 75459) running in a generally east north easterly direction for approximately 87 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 50564 75492) then in a generally easterly then east south easterly direction for approximately 91.5 metres to point C (Grid Reference ST 50653 75483), then in a generally northerly direction for approximately 6 metres to point D (Grid Reference ST 50655 75488) and then in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 25.5 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST 50675 75473) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 145.

Public Footpath LA 15/5

That part of Public Footpath LA 15/5 in the Parish of Portbury from point F (Grid Reference ST 50613 75432) running in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 67.5 metres to point C (Grid Reference ST 50653 75483) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 145.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF ALTERNATIVE HIGHWAYS

Public Footpath LA 15/4

A Public Footpath in the Parish of Portbury from point A (Grid Reference ST 50484 75459) running in an east north easterly direction for approximately 96 metres to a pedestrian gate at point G (Grid Reference ST 50579 75475), with a width of 2 metres, as shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 145.

Public Footpath LA 15/5

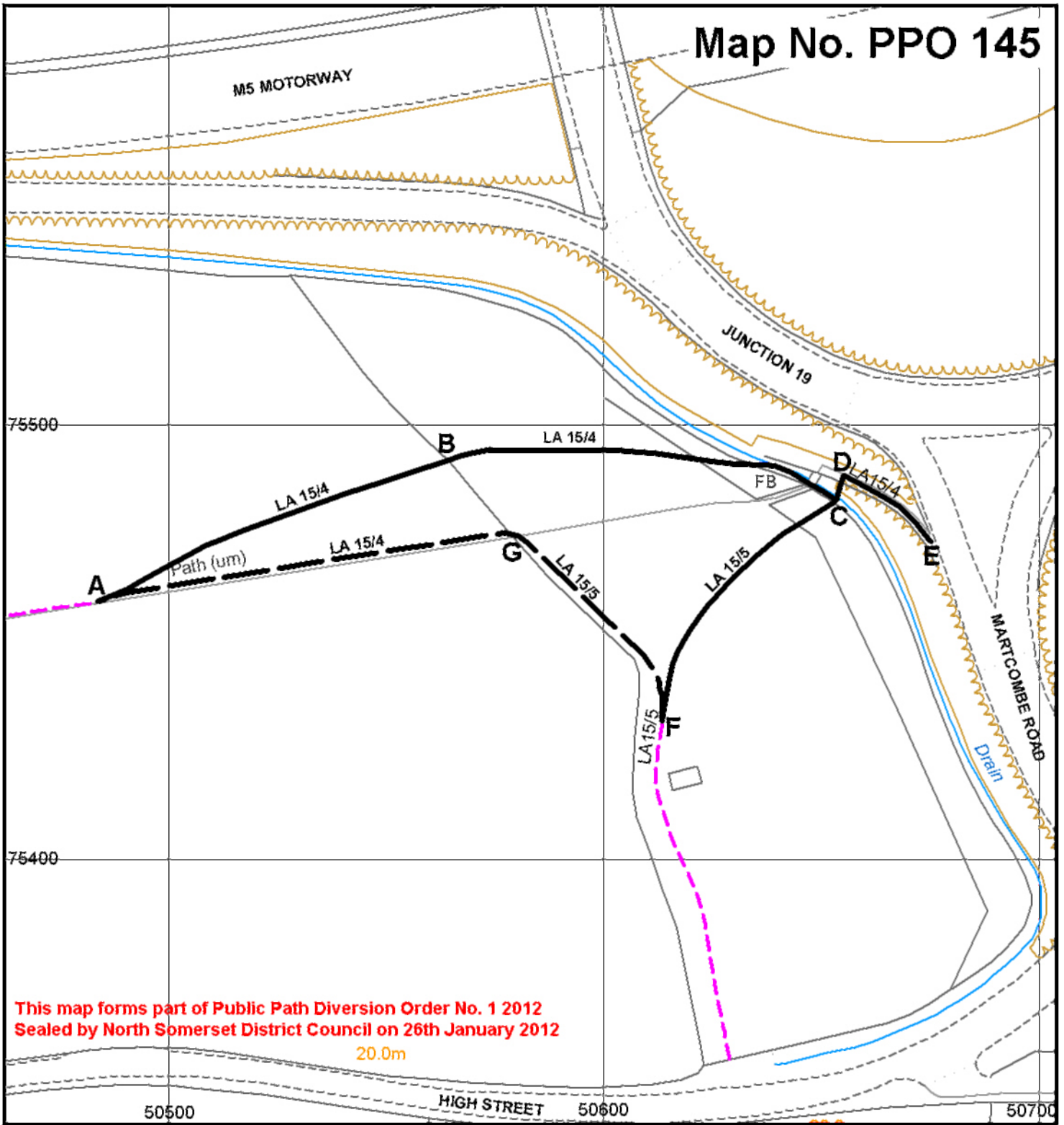
A Public Footpath in the Parish of Portbury running from point F (Grid Reference ST 50613 75432) running in a generally northerly then north westerly direction for approximately 57.5 metres to point G (Grid Ref. ST 50579 75475), with a width of 2 metres, as shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 145.

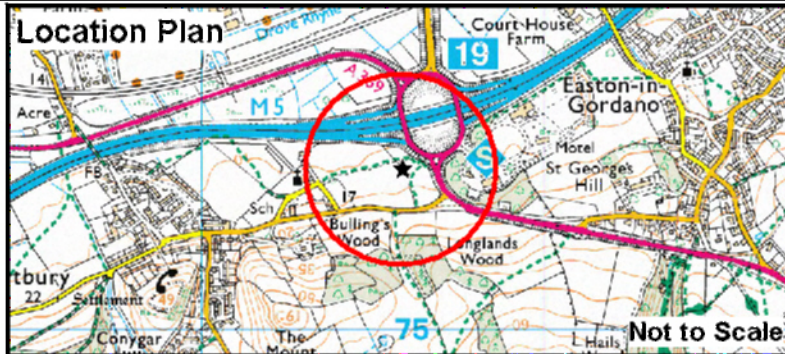
