

Fly-posting and graffiti

Service summary:

We will remove fly-posting and graffiti on council land and property, and will take steps to prevent it happening again.

We will:

- remove graffiti and fly-posting on council land and property within seven days of being notified
- make the removal of abusive or offensive items a priority
- use only trained teams to remove graffiti
- collect evidence and records of fly-posting and graffiti and pass them to the police as part of our work to tackle crime and disorder
- use CCTV to provide evidence in prosecutions.

You can help by:

- reporting to us if you see any fly-posting or graffiti.

The service does not include:

- removal of graffiti and fly-posting from private land and buildings.

Fly-posting and graffiti removal service

1. Can I put up signs or posters in North Somerset?

Not without specific planning permission, and never on street furniture or on the highway. We can prosecute offenders.

2. Can you remove graffiti or fly-posting from my wall?

We only remove graffiti and fly-posting from the council's land and buildings. Privately owned structures are the responsibility of the owner.
