HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL
(FOOTPATH LA 20/21, FIR TREES, STONEY STEEP, WRAXALL)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER NO. 15 2011

The above Order, made on 22nd September 2011, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert part of Public Footpath LA 20/21 in the Parish of Wraxall and Failand within the District of North Somerset as described below:

That part of Public Footpath LA 20/21 in the Parish of Wraxall and Failand from point A (Grid Reference ST 48413 72098) on Stoney Steep, Wraxall running in a north westerly, then south westerly direction for approximately 203 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 48222 72125) shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 137 to a footpath from point A (Grid Reference ST 48413 72098), running in a westerly, then north westerly direction for approximately 197 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 48222 72125) shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 137. The new path will have a width of 2 metres.

New pedestrian gates (to BS5709.2006) will be provided at points A and B as illustrated on the Order Map No. PPO 137.

A copy of the Order and Order map has been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Reception Desk, Council Offices, Castlewood, Tickenham Road, Clevedon (opposite Clevedon Garages) from 9.00am to 4.30pm Monday to Thursday (4.00pm Friday) or may be viewed on the Council's Web site (www.n-somerset.gov.uk / Your Council / Local Democracy / Public and Legal Notices). A copy is also available for inspection at Nailsea Library, Somerset Square, Nailsea, Bristol, BS48 1RQ during the following opening hours (9.30am to 5.00pm Wednesday and Thursday, 9.30am to 7.00pm Tuesday and Friday, 9.30am to 4.00pm Saturdays).

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Director of Development and Environment, Natural Environment Team, Streets and Open Spaces, Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, BS23 1UJ not later than **Thursday 17 November 2011** (quoting reference **EB/PPO 137**). Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Somerset District Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER No. 15 2011

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council (“the authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of the order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The applicants have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Fir Trees, Stoney Steep, Wraxall and shown by a bold continuous line on the Map No. PPO 137 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up on the date on which North Somerset District Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highway mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. Notwithstanding this order Open Reach BT shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely: they shall for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they had immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted.
3. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situated at Fir Trees, Stoney Steep, Wraxall described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Map No. PPO 137 attached to this order.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

That part of Public Footpath LA 20/21 in the Parish of Wraxall and Failand from point A (Grid Reference ST 48413 72098) running in a north westerly, then south westerly direction for approximately 203 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 48222 72125) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 137.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

The new Footpath LA 20/21 in the Parish of Wraxall and Failand will commence from point A (Grid Reference ST 48413 72098), running in a westerly, then north westerly direction for approximately 197 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 48222 72125) as shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 137. The new path will have a width of 2 metres.

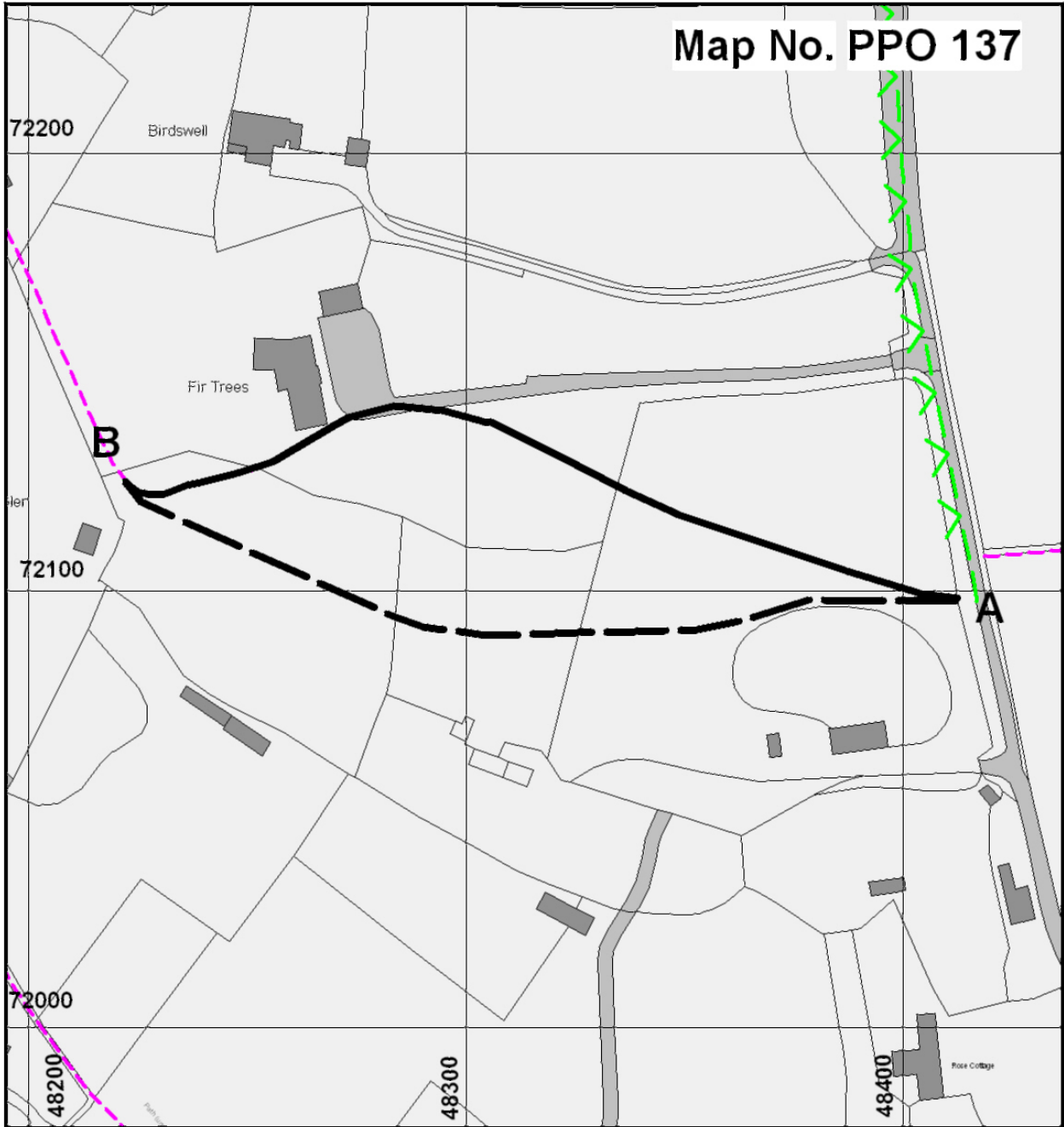
