

NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL
(FOOTPATH LA 6/13, LA 6/14 and LA 6/15 MAIN ROAD CLEEVE)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER NO. 13 2011

AND

(UNRECORDED FOOTPATH TO THE SIDE OF 147 MAIN ROAD CLEEVE)
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER NO. 14 2011

The above Orders, made on 22nd September 2011, under section 118 and 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert those parts of Public Footpath LA 6/13, LA 6/14 and LA 6/15 in the Parish of Cleeve and extinguish an unrecorded route to the side of 147 Main Road Cleeve within the District of North Somerset as described below:

That part of Public Footpath LA 6/14 from point A (Grid Reference ST46229 66583) running in a south easterly direction for approximately 200 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST46306 66399) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 144a to a footpath from point A (Grid Reference ST46229 66583) runs in a generally east south easterly direction for approximately 144 metres to point F (Grid Reference ST46367 66550) then south easterly direction for approximately 114 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST46448 66487) as shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 144a.

That part of Public Footpath LA 6/15 from point C (Grid Reference ST46192 66510) running in an east south easterly direction for approximately 109 metres to point D (Grid Reference ST46306 66399) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 144a to a footpath from point C (Grid Reference ST46192 66510) running in a north north easterly direction for approximately 83 metres to point A (Grid Reference ST46229 66583) as shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 144a.

That part of Public Footpath LA 6/13 from point C (Grid Reference ST46192 66510) running in an easterly direction for approximately 258 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST46448 66487) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 144a to a footpath from point C (Grid Reference ST46192 66510) running in an east north easterly direction for approximately 180 metres to point F (Grid Reference ST46367 66550) as shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 144a.

That part of an unrecorded footpath at the side of No 147 Main Road from point M (Grid Reference ST 46266 66490) running in a generally south easterly direction to point N (Grid Reference ST 46328 66415), its junction with the A370 Main Road Cleeve, a total distance of approximately 97 metres will be extinguished, as shown by a continuous bold line on Map No. PPO144b.

All of the new routes described above will be provided to a width of 3 metres.

New kissing gates (to BS5709.2006) will be provided at points C, A and E, as illustrated on the Order Map No. PPO 144a.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Director of Development and Environment, Natural Environment Team, Streets and Open Spaces, Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, BS23 1UJ not later than **Thursday 27 October 2011** (quoting reference **EB/PPO 144**). Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Somerset District Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER No. 13 2011

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council (“the authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of the order it is expedient that the line of the paths should be diverted.

The applicants have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the paths into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1 The public rights of way over the land situated at Main Road Cleeve and shown by a bold continuous line on the Map No. PPO 144a contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up on the date on which North Somerset District Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highway mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. Notwithstanding this order Western Power Distribution and Open Reach BT shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely: they shall for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they had immediately before the date on which the footpaths are diverted.
3. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be public footpaths over the land situated at Main Road Cleeve described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Map No. PPO 144a attached to this order.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

That part of Public Footpath LA 6/14 in the Parish of Cleeve from point A (Grid Reference ST46229 66583) running in a south easterly direction for approximately 200 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST46306 66399) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 144a.

That part of Public Footpath LA 6/15 in the Parish of Cleeve from point C (Grid Reference ST46192 66510) running in an east south easterly direction for approximately 109 metres to point D (Grid Reference ST46306 66399) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 144a.

That part of Public Footpath LA 6/13 in the Parish of Cleeve from point C (Grid Reference ST46192 66510) running in an easterly direction for approximately 258 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST46448 66487) as shown by a bold continuous line on Map No. PPO 144a.

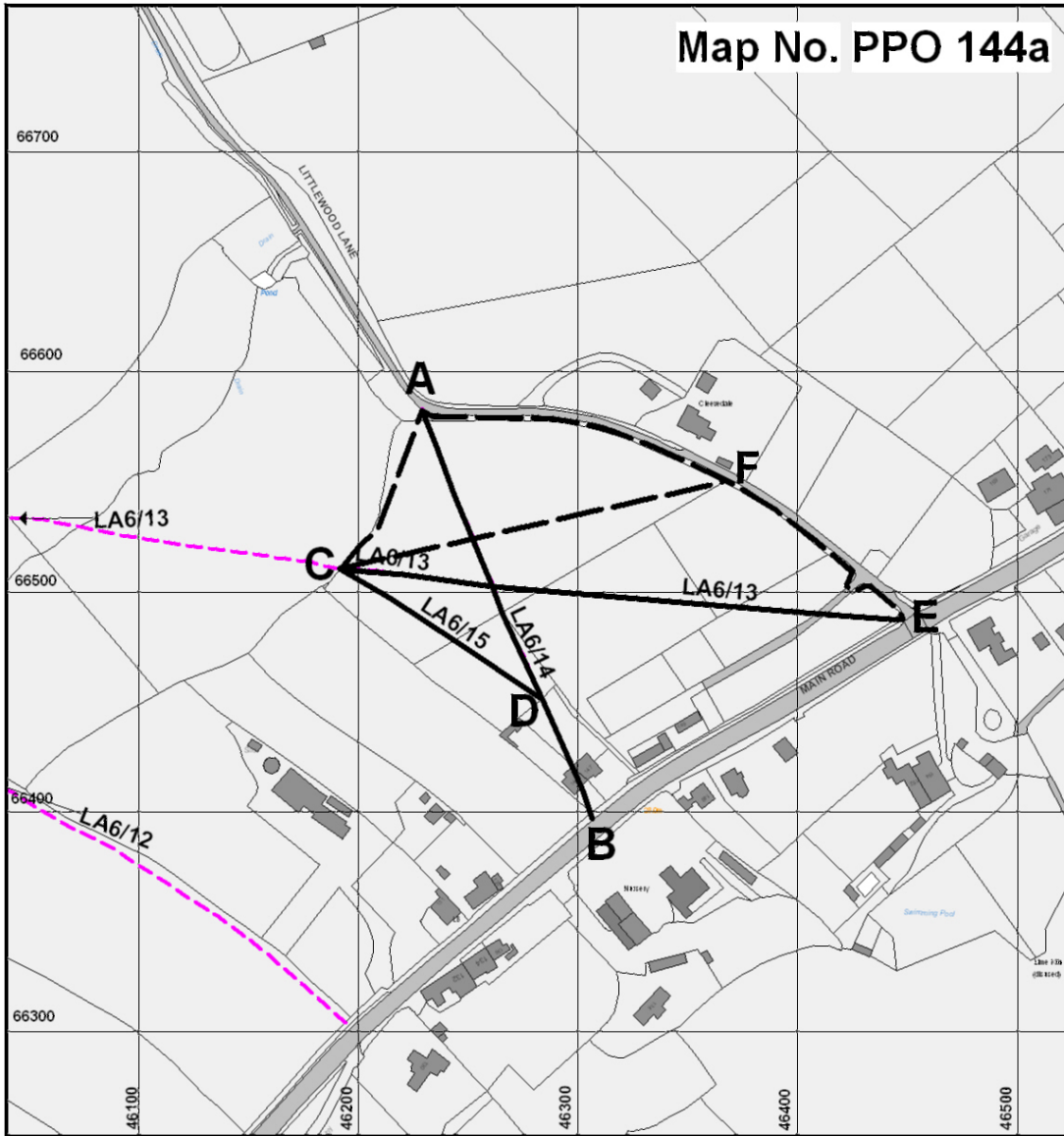
DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

LA 6/14 - A footpath from point A (Grid Reference ST46229 66583), runs in a generally east south easterly direction for approximately 144 metres to point F (Grid Reference ST46367 66550) then south easterly direction for approximately 114 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST46448 66487). The new path will have a width of 3 metres and is shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 144a.

LA 6/15 - A footpath from point C (Grid Reference ST46192 66510) running in a north north easterly direction for approximately 83 metres to point A (Grid Reference ST46229 66583). The new path will have a width of 3 metres and is shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 144a.

LA 6/13 - A footpath from point C (Grid Reference ST46192 66510) running in an east north easterly direction for approximately 180 metres to point F (Grid Reference ST46367 66550). The new path will have a width of 3 metres and is shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 144a.

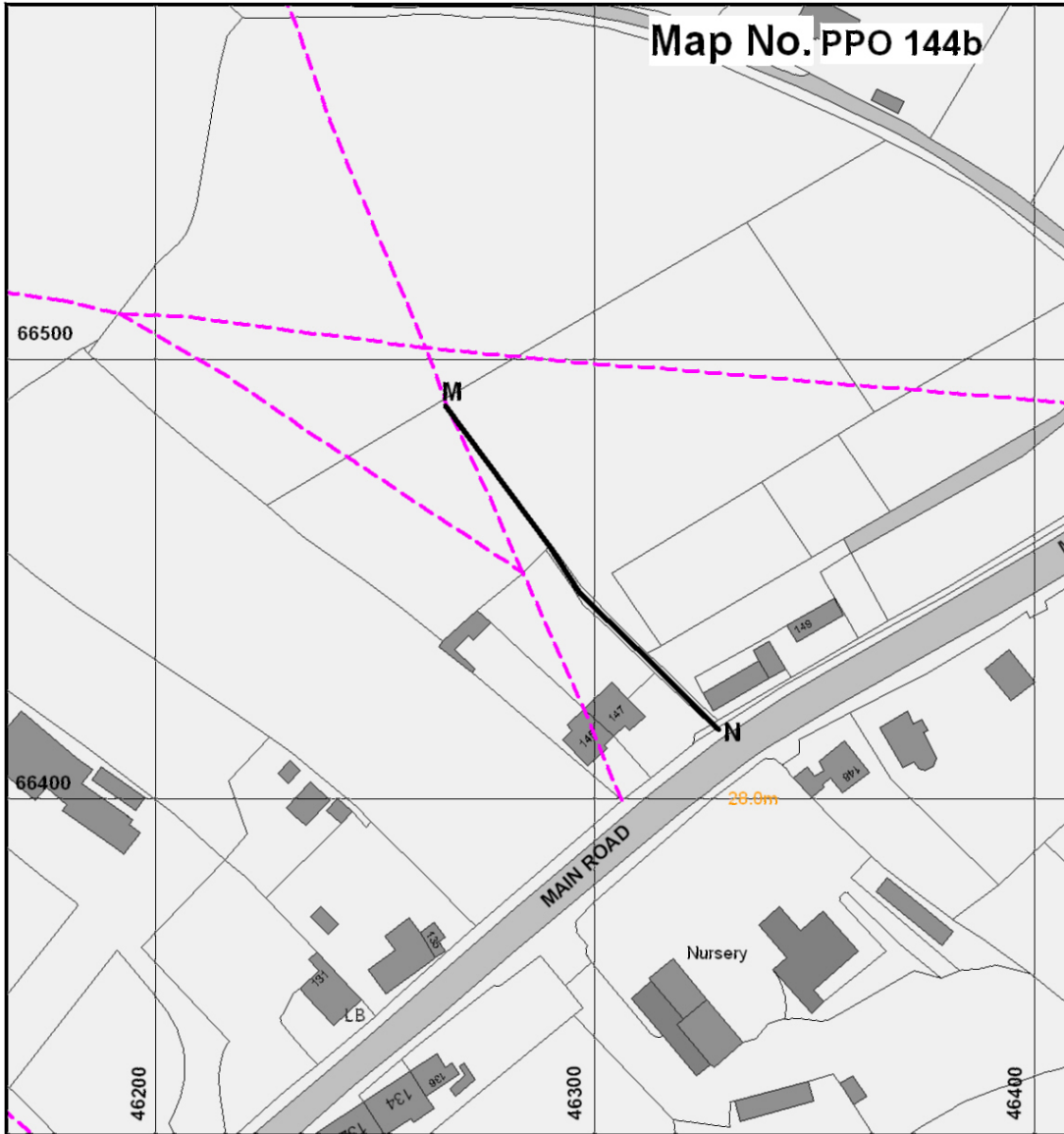
BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at the side of No. 147 Main Road Cleeve and shown by a continuous bold line on the map PPO144b attached to this order and described in the Schedule to this order shall be extinguished after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
2. Notwithstanding this order Western Power Distribution and Open Reach BT shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely: they shall for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they had immediately before the date on which the footpath is extinguished.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

That part of an unrecorded footpath at the side of No 147 Main Road in the Parish of Cleeve from point M (Grid Reference ST 46266 66490) running in a generally south easterly direction to point N (Grid Reference ST 46328 66415), its junction with the A370 Main Road Cleeve, a total distance of approximately 97 metres, as shown by a continuous bold line on the attached Map No. PPO144b.
