



Affordable Housing Supplementary Planning Document

ADOPTION STATEMENT

(TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (LOCAL DEVELOPMENT) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2004 (19).

This supplementary planning document (SPD) is in accordance with policy H/4 and H/5 of the North Somerset Replacement Local Plan setting out in more detail how North Somerset Council interprets the above policies and its preferred method for delivering affordable housing.

The draft brief was approved for the purposes of consultation on 30 October 2007. The period of public consultation took place between 29th November 2007 and 10 January 2008. A copy of the document was sent to statutory consultation bodies, Parish and Town Councils, neighbouring Authorities and other specific consultation bodies.

Copies of the document were also available for inspection and to make on-line comments on the Council's website (www.n-somerset.gov.uk); and at the Council Offices at the Somerset House, Oxford Street, Weston-super-Mare BS23 1TG during their normal office hours.

A summary of the representations made and the recommendations made in response are set out in the **Consultation Statement** in accordance with regulation 18 (4) (b) of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, which is made available on-line and at the Council offices.

The SPD was formally adopted as a Supplementary Planning Document by the Executive on 2 June 2008.

Any person aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPD. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 2 September 2008.
