

**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

**NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL**  
**(FOOTPATH LA 20/42 TYNTESFIELD SPRINGS BRISTOL ROAD WRAXALL**  
**AND FAILAND) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER No. 6 2011**

The above Order, made on 7 April 2011, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert Public Footpath LA 20/42 in the Parish of Wraxall and Failand within the District of North Somerset as described below, from:

Grid Reference ST 50008 70605, its junction with Footpath LA20/40, running in a generally east south easterly direction for approximately 84 metres then a north easterly direction for approximately 164 metres to Grid Reference ST 50240 70656, its junction with Restricted Byway LA 20/51 as shown by a bold continuous line on the Order Map No. PPO 142; to

Grid Reference ST 50031 70534, its junction with Footpath LA 20/52, running in an easterly direction for approximately 81 metres to Grid Reference ST 50112 70531 and then in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 56 metres to Grid Reference ST 50143 70488, its junction with Restricted Byway LA20/51 as shown by a bold broken line on the Order Map No. PPO142. This footpath will be known as Footpath LA 20/42 having a width of 2 metres.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Director of Development and Environment, Natural Environment Team, Streets and Open Spaces, Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, BS23 1UJ no later than **Monday 16 May 2011** (quoting reference **EB/PPO 142**). Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Somerset District Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER No. 6 2011**

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council (“the authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the footpath should be diverted.

The applicants have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Tyntesfield Springs Bristol Road Wraxall and Failand shown by a bold continuous line on the Map No. PPO 142 contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. Notwithstanding this order Western Power Distribution shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely : they shall for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they had immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted.
3. There shall from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Tyntesfield Springs Bristol Road Wraxall and Failand described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Map No. PPO 142 attached to this Order.

## **SCHEDULE**

### **PART 1**

#### **DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY**

Public Footpath LA 20/42 in the Parish of Wraxall and Failand within the District of North Somerset from point A (Grid Reference ST 50008 70605) running in a generally east south easterly direction for approximately 84 metres then a north easterly direction for approximately 164 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 50240 70656) as shown by a bold continuous line on the Map No. PPO 142 contained in this Order.

### **PART 2**

#### **DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY**

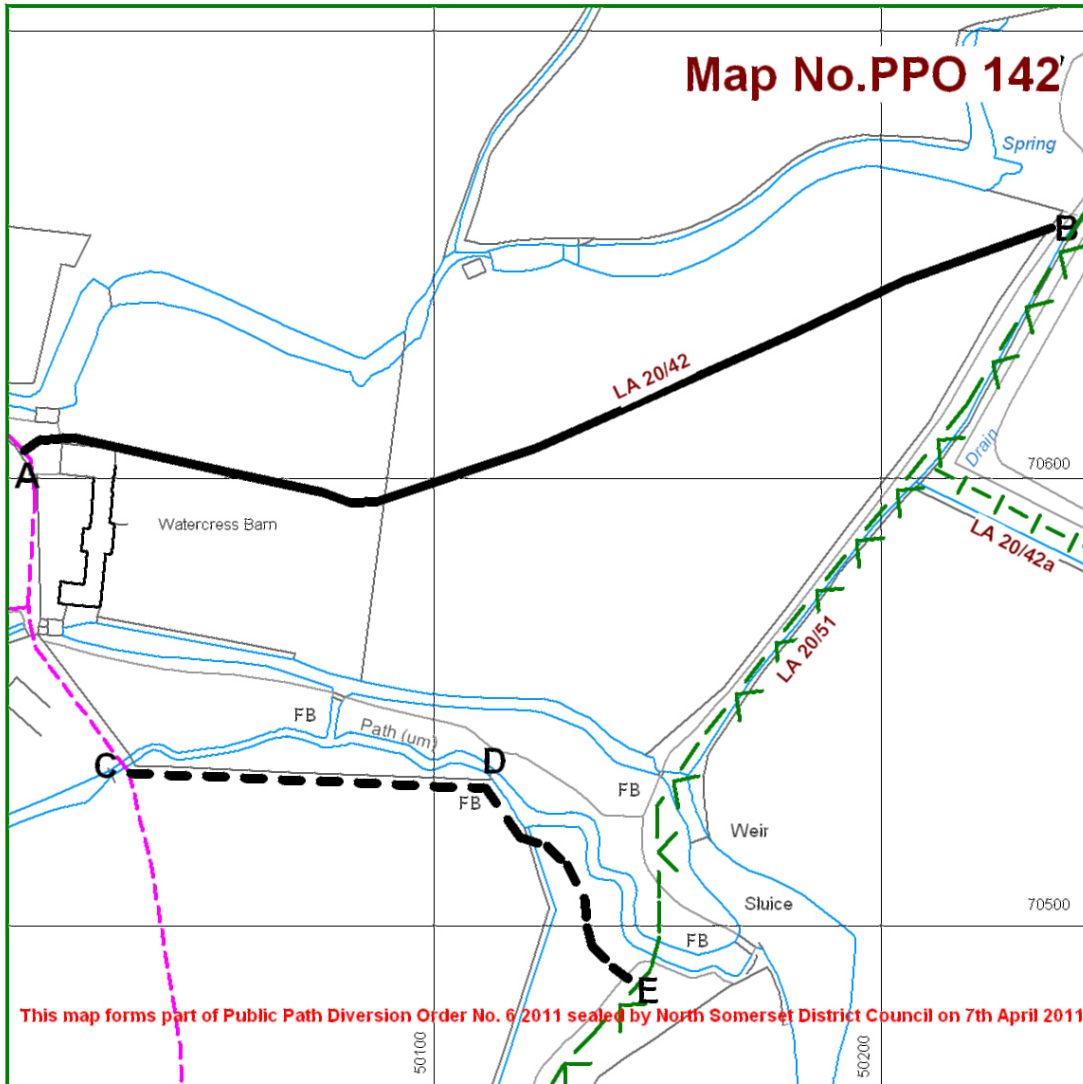
A Public Footpath commencing at point C (Grid Reference ST 50031 70534) running in an easterly direction for approximately 81 metres to point D (Grid Reference ST 50112 70531) and then in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 56 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST 50143 70488) and having a width of 2 metres as shown by a bold broken line on the Map No. PPO 142 contained in this Order. This footpath will be known as Footpath LA 20/42.
