PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER NO. 8 2011**

The above Orders were made on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2011. The effect of the Orders will be to stop up those parts of Public Footpaths LA 3/29, LA 2/39 and LA 2/47 and divert those parts of Public Footpaths LA 3/26 and LA 2/40 in the Parishes of Barrow Gurney and Backwell within the District of North Somerset as described below:

**Public Path Stopping Up Order No. 7 2011 (ref. PPO 119/7/2011) will stop up:**

that part of **Public Footpath LA 3/29** in the Parish of Barrow Gurney from the junction with the Restricted Byway LA 3/22 at point A (Grid Reference ST 51171 67326) running in a generally south, south westerly direction for approximately 88 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 51149 67240), then in a generally southerly direction for approximately 22 metres to the junction with Public Footpath LA 2/47 at point C (Grid Reference ST 51147 67219) and then in a generally south, south easterly direction for approximately 453 metres to the junction with Public Footpath LA 2/39 at the Parish boundary at point D (Grid Reference ST 51201 66771), as shown by a bold black line on the Order Map No. PPO 119/7/2011;

that part of **Public Footpath LA 2/39** in the Parish of Backwell from the junction with Public Footpath LA 3/29 at the Parish boundary at point D (Grid Reference ST 51201 66771) running in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 158 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST 51290 66640) and then in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 10 metres to point F (Grid Reference ST 51297 66632), as shown by a bold black line on the Order Map No. PPO 119/7/2011

**and** that part of **Public Footpath LA 2/47** in the Parish of Barrow Gurney from the junction with Public Footpath LA 3/29 at point C (Grid Reference ST 51147 67219) running in a generally south, south westerly direction for approximately 3 metres to the Parish boundary at point G (Grid Reference ST 51146 67216) and then running in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 369 metres to the junction with Restricted Byway LA 2/51 at point H (Grid Reference ST 50949 66905), as shown by a bold black line on the Order Map No. PPO 119/7/2011.

**Public Path Diversion Order No. 8 2011 (ref. PPO 119/8/2011) will divert, from:**

that part of **Public Footpath LA 3/26** in the Parishes of Barrow Gurney and Backwell which runs from point I (Grid Reference ST 51305 66635) in a generally west north westerly direction for approximately 16 metres to the junction with Public Footpath LA 2/40 at point E (Grid Reference ST 51290 66640) as shown by a bold black line on the Order Map No. PPO 119/8/2011

**and** that part of **Public Footpath LA 2/40** in the Parish of Backwell which runs from the junction with Public Footpath LA 3/26 at point E (Grid Reference ST 51290 66640) in a generally west north westerly direction for approximately 423 metres to point J (Grid Reference ST 50942 66875) as shown by a bold black line on the Order Map No. PPO 119/8/2011;

**to a Public Footpath (LA 3/26)** in the Parish of Barrow Gurney running from point I (Grid Reference ST 51305 66635) in a generally west south westerly direction for approximately 4 metres to the parish boundary and junction with Public Footpath LA 2/40, at point K (Grid Reference ST 51300 66634), with a width of 2.5 metres, as shown by bold black dashes on the attached Map No. PPO 119/8/2011.

**and to a Public Footpath (LA 2/40)** in the Parish of Backwell running from the Parish boundary and junction with Public Footpath LA 3/26 at point K (Grid Reference ST 51300 66634) in a generally west south westerly direction for approximately 4 metres to the junction with Public Footpath LA 2/39 at point F (Grid Reference 51297 66632) and then in a generally west north westerly direction for approximately 445 metres to the junction with Restricted Byway LA 2/51 at point L (Grid Reference ST 50902 66798), with a width of 2.5 metres, as shown by bold black dashes on the attached Map No. PPO 119/8/2011.

Reference to Points A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K and L above are references to the points marked on the Order Map Nos. PPO 119/7/2011 and PPO 119/8/2011.

If the Orders are sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

**PUBLIC PATH STOPPING UP ORDER NO. 7 2011**

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council (“the authority”) under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to stop up the footpaths to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely: to facilitate the ongoing implementation of planning permission 1996/92, for the winning and working of limestone at land at Freemans Farm and planning permission 09/P/0270/F, for the erection of a temporary overburden storage bund at land adjacent to Freemans Quarry.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The footpaths over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached Map No. PPO 119/7/2011 and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order (“the Schedule”) shall be stopped up as provided below.
2. The stopping up of the footpaths shall have effect on the confirmation of this Order.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS**

##### **Public Footpath LA 3/29**

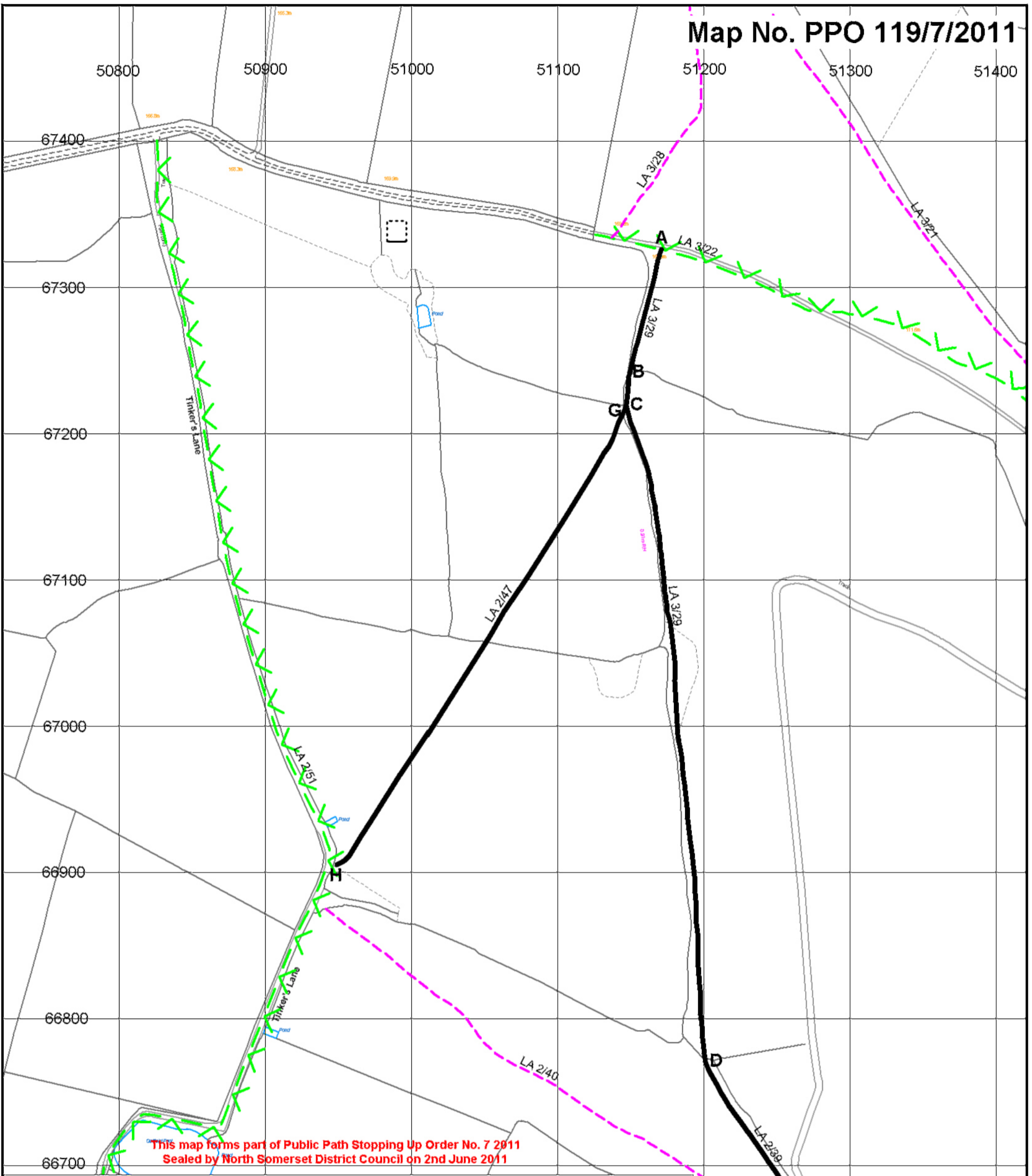
That part of Public Footpath LA 3/29 in the Parish of Barrow Gurney from the junction with the Restricted Byway LA 3/22 at point A (Grid Reference ST 51171 67326) running in a generally south, south westerly direction for approximately 88 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 51149 67240), then in a generally southerly direction for approximately 22 metres to the junction with Public Footpath LA 2/47 at point C (Grid Reference ST 51147 67219) and then in a generally south, south easterly direction for approximately 453 metres to the junction with Public Footpath LA 2/39 at the Parish boundary at point D (Grid Reference ST 51201 66771), as shown by a bold black line on the attached Map No. PPO 119/7/2011.

##### **Public Footpath LA 2/39**

That part of Public Footpath LA 2/39 in the Parish of Backwell from the junction with Public Footpath LA 3/29 at the Parish boundary at point D (Grid Reference ST 51201 66771) running in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 158 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST 51290 66640) and then in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 10 metres to point F (Grid Reference ST 51297 66632), as shown by a bold black line on the attached Map No. PPO 119/7/2011.

##### **Public Footpath LA 2/47**

That part of Public Footpath LA 2/47 in the Parish of Barrow Gurney from the junction with Public Footpath LA 3/29 at point C (Grid Reference ST 51147 67219) running in a generally south, south westerly direction for approximately 3 metres to the Parish boundary at point G (Grid Reference ST 51146 67216) and then running in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 369 metres to the junction with Restricted Byway LA 2/51 at point H (Grid Reference ST 50949 66905), as shown by a bold black line on the attached Map No. PPO 119/7/2011.
