

Rambling around Regil

See a tranquil waterfall in a beautiful countryside setting during this circular walk around Regil, in the parish of Winford.

Continue ahead towards the stile next to the metal gate. Cross this and head down to the far right corner, to exit the field over a stile into the lane (Whitling Street).

Turn right into the lane and you will soon see a gate on your left-hand side, with a stile next to it. This path joins the Monarch Way recreational route so keep dogs on leads and stay on the path.



Regil is a pretty village near North Somerset's border. This walk begins next to the church, near the village green.

The public footpath sign is to the right of the church, leading to a gate. There are two paths you can follow but take the right-hand route over the stile, with a yellow way-marker pointing ahead.

Continue across this field and go through the farmyard, through a kissing gate and continue ahead through another kissing gate.

Follow the fenced-off footpath around the field and then go through another gate. Follow the yellow way-marker down the field to the kissing gate you can see in the fence ahead.

How to get there

Car: Regil is on the Regil Road, south of Winford. Park by the village green, near the red telephone box.

Go straight across the field, over another stile, and then veer towards the stile on the right, in the hedge. Take care going down the stone steps onto the lane. Cross the lane and go through the metal gate directly in front of you, to enter the next field.



Walk information

Distance: about 3 miles

Difficulty: medium. A few stiles – not suitable for very large dogs. Wear wellies

Duration: 2.5 hours

Map: OS Explorer 154

Refreshments: The Crown Inn is on the road between Winford and Regil

This route opens up into a field and the public footpath continues along the left-hand edge. Head towards the corner and go through the kissing gate. Continue ahead, then go through another kissing gate over a little wooden bridge.

The footpath continues straight across the field but if you veer to your left first, you will see a gate and some steps leading down to a picturesque waterfall.



Enjoy this tranquil spot before returning to the field and going through the stile. Continue ahead, through the next gate, and then keep heading straight across the field.

Go over the next stile and then veer to the bottom corner of the next field. Go over another stile and continue ahead towards the farm buildings.

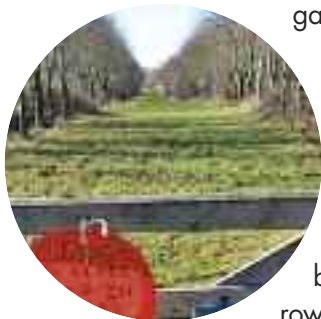
Go through this kissing gate then veer right to the next stile (there is a gate in this stile for dogs).



Continue ahead, walking across the middle of the field, and go through a gap in the trees. The field veers downhill, so head towards a kissing gate in the far corner, next to the trees. Cross the little bridge and continue ahead across the next field.

At the end of the field, the public footpath divides in two. Go through the wooden kissing gate on the right-hand side, to go along the path between the trees. This veers downhill and is fairly uneven, so take care.

At the end of the path go through the kissing gate and turn right. This leads to another kissing gate next to a metal gate, which leads into a habitat scheme with a grassy path between two rows of trees.



At the end of this path the route veers to the right, between the trees. This part is not dedicated as a public right of way but is a permissive path for people to follow.

Go through the two gates and turn right onto the lane.

At the fork in the lane you will see another stile pointing across the field. Continue across the field until you see a stile on your left with a yellow way-marker on it. Climb over this then keep to the right of the field, with the hedge on your right.

Cut through the trees at the top and then continue through to the gate in the hedge, which is directly in front of you. Continue ahead across the field, towards the farm buildings, and exit the farm through the gates. This brings you out onto the lane which will take you back to the centre of Regil.
