Your mobile library

- Is easy and free to join: just bring along some identification that shows your name and address and you can join and borrow items straight away. If you already have a library card from North Somerset, or any of our neighbouring authorities, you can use it on the mobile library.
- Carries a wide selection of books, suitable for all ages and including talking books and large print books. There is a small charge (50p per item) for requests made on the mobile library. If we do not have the item you are looking for, please ask the staff to request it for you.
- Has a lift to aid access to the vehicle – just ask the staff

Items borrowed from the mobile library may be returned or renewed at any library in North Somerset or our neighbouring councils.

You can renew items at any library or by calling **0845 002 0777**; this is an automated, local rate, 24 hour service*

You will not be charged fines for any items borrowed from the mobile library which become overdue. However, to help us provide you with the best possible service we would ask that you either return or renew all items by the date they are due. If you provide us with an email address, we will send you a helpful reminder, a few days before your items become due.
