The above Order made on 18th August 2011, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by upgrading part of Footpath AX 16/37 to bridleway and adding a new bridleway to the network to be known as Bridleway AX16/56.

Bridleway AX 16/37 will commence at its junction with Bridleway AX16/22 Point A Grid Ref ST 4206063755 and proceed in a south easterly direction for 130 metres to Point B Grid Ref ST 4211863641 through a field gate and continues in a southerly direction for 280 metres to Point C Grid Ref ST 4214863364, then east south easterly direction for 310 metres to Point D Grid Ref ST 4246263318. This section of bridleway is 720 metres in length. The width of the bridleway between Point A and B is defined by the boundaries of the track a width of 3 metres, between B and C a width of 3 metres from the hedgerow on the easterly side and between Point C and D is defined by the width of the track and the rhymes on either side varying between 6 and 7 metres in width.

Bridleway AX 16/56 will commence from Point D Grid Ref ST 4246263318 and proceeds in an easterly direction for 720 metres to Point E Grid Ref ST 4317163398 where it proceeds for a distance of 70 metres crossing the former railway lines to Point F Grid Ref ST 4323763400, then proceeds in an easterly direction for 370 metres to Point G Grid Ref ST 4361263450, then northerly direction for 110 metres to Point H Grid Ref ST 4364663546, then north easterly direction for a distance of 110 metres to Point J Grid Ref ST 4375263576. This section of bridleway is 1380 metres in length. The width of the bridleway between Point D and J is defined by the width of the track and the rhymes or hedging on either side. This bridleway varies between 3 and 8 metres in width.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Director of Development & Environment, North Somerset Council, Streets and Open Spaces, Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston Super Mare, BS23 1UJ not later than 13th October 2011, applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Somerset Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or that part of the Order). If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council (“the Council”) under section 53(2)(a) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (“the Act”) because the Secretary of State has directed under paragraph 4(2) of Schedule 14 of the Act that an order be made because it appears to the Secretary of State that the County of Somerset Definitive Map and Statement Axbridge Rural District requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) and (ii) namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows (i) that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or; subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic; and (ii) that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description.

The Council have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 1 August 2011.
2. The County of Somerset Definitive Map and Statement Axbridge Rural District shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the North Somerset District Council (Part of Footpath AX 16/37 and unrecorded section known as Dolemoor Lane Congresbury) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order No 4 2011.

This section of bridleway is 720 metres in length. The width of the bridleway between Point A and B is defined by the boundaries of the track a width of 3 metres, between B and C a width of 3 metres from the hedgerow on the easterly side and between Point C and D is defined by the width of the track and the rhymes on either side varying between 6 and 7 metres in width.

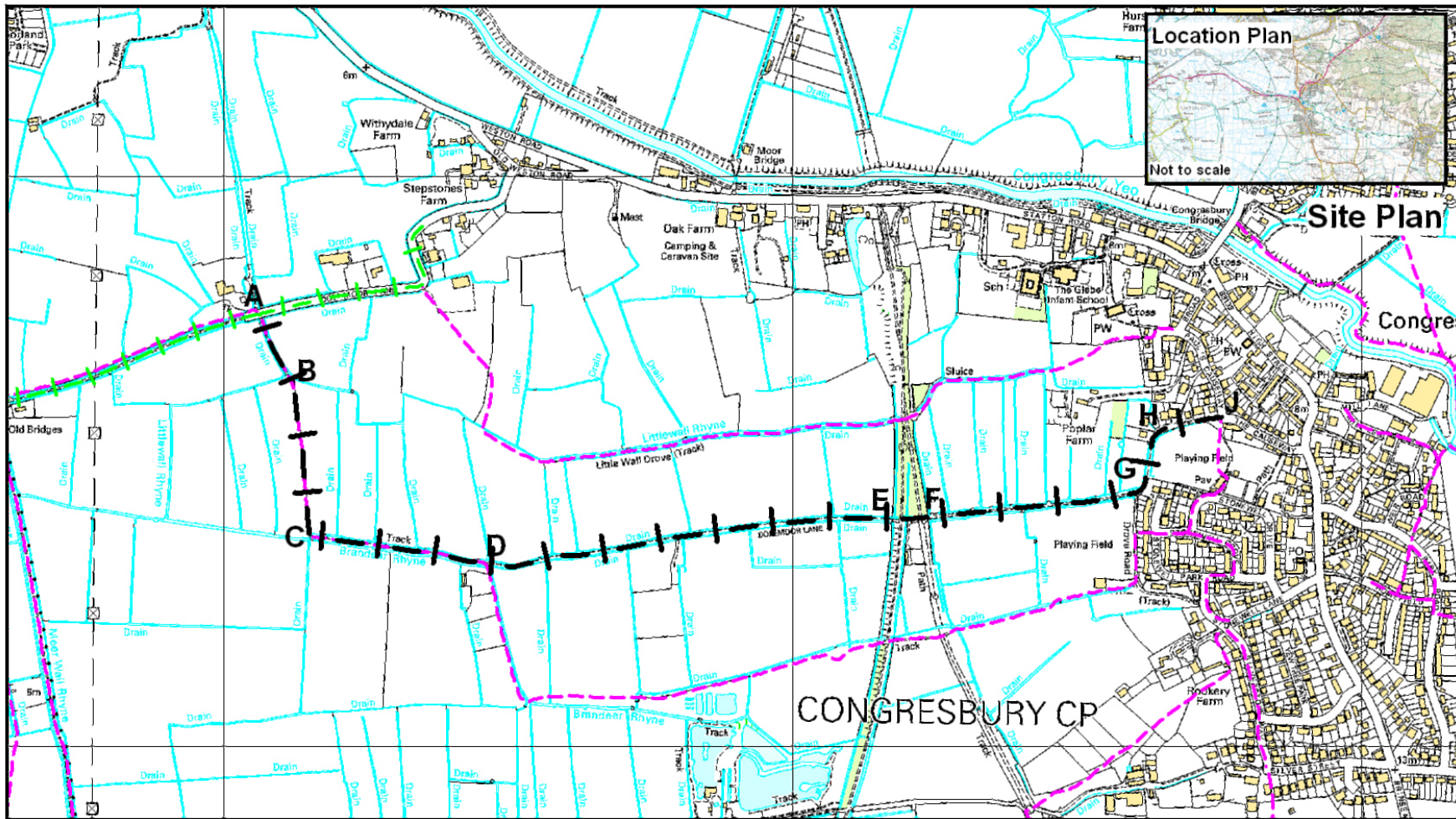
