

<p>Working Party would communicate with neighbouring towns and parishes to establish where their proposed cycle tracks would link into Nailsea.</p> <p>NTCWP together with interested residents design "Safe Cycles Routes" throughout Nailsea to "benefit our community" not at our expense and without interference from any outsiders.</p> <p>NTCWP had also looked at route through Nailsea to North Drove to eventually link to Clevedon.</p> <p>The only concession to this statement would be to gain approval and agreement with Sustrans and North Somerset Officers over the proposed routes.</p> <p>7 .Clevedon and Portishead Cycle Routes</p> <p>EH reported that Transition Clevedon's transport section is pushing the Weston-Clevedon link. The town paths that are in existence need to be carefully considered as some have been designated shared paths whilst others it is not clear. The routes need to be publicised for wider consideration.</p> <p>8. Cycle Forum – terms of reference review</p> <p>AR had discussed with MJ the existing terms of reference (2006). Detail and extent of terms were discussed and it was agreed that AR draft amendments ahead of the next forum meeting to be held in November. The forum asked if they could become statutory consultees.</p> <p>9. AOB</p> <p>MJ has stepped down as chair due to business commitments and nominations invited for temporary chair for this and subsequent meeting. Willing to stand as chair Adrian Read proposed by James Tonkin and seconded by Angela Neale was duly elected with no other nominations received. It was agreed to publicise the position of chair and invite nominations once the terms of reference and a constitution have been agreed by a subsequent meeting.
