The above Order made on 21 July 2011, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:

Upgrading to bridleway status public footpath AX29/37 in the parish of Winscombe commencing at its boundary with Somerset County Council Point A Grid Reference ST 4363256593 and proceeding in a west south westerly direction for 922 metres to Point B Grid Reference ST 4275256394, then south westerly direction for 449 metres to Point C ST 4244956086, then westerly direction for 185 to Point D Grid Reference ST 4227956119, its junction with the A38 Bridgewater Road. The track between Point A and Point D is bounded on both sides by natural hedgerow with field entrances and has a varying width. Between A and B the width varies between 2.5 and 3 metres, between B and C the width varies between 2 and 4.5 metres and between C and D the width varies between 2 and 4.5 metres.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Somerset Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or

that part of the Order). If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council (“the Council”) under section 53(2)(a) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (“the Act”) because it appears to that authority that the County of Somerset Definitive Map and Statement Axbridge Rural District requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(ii) namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description and section 53 (3) (b) of the Act, namely, the expiration, in relation to any way in the area to which the map relates, of any period such that the enjoyment by the public of the way during that period raises a presumption that the way has been dedicated as a bridleway.

The Council have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 1 July 2011.
2. The County of Somerset Definitive Map and Statement Axbridge Rural District shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the North Somerset District Council Footpath AX 29/37 Winscombe Drove Winscombe Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order No 3 2011.

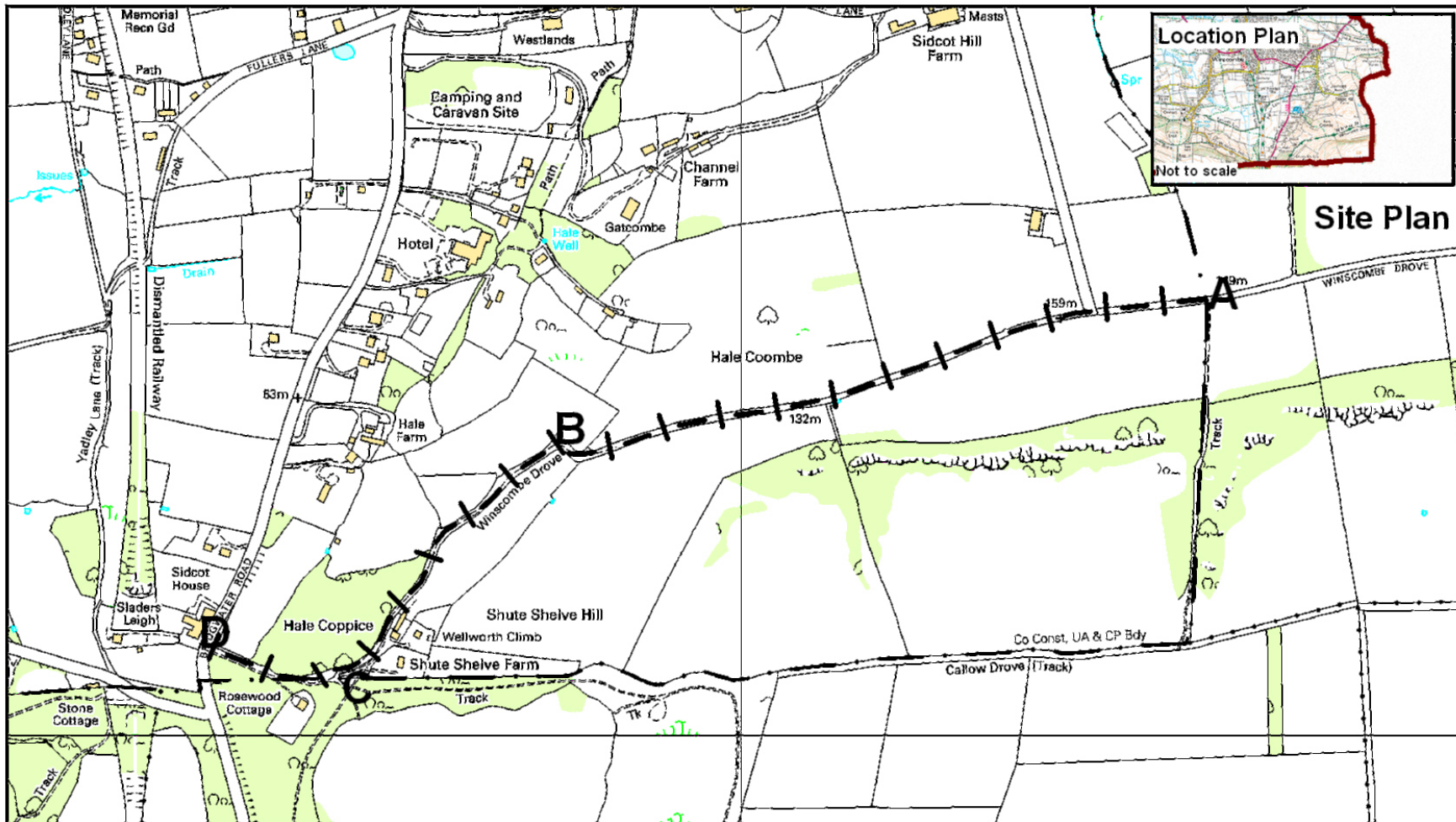
