

NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL
(FOOTPATH LA 22/49, SOUTHFIELD FARM, LOWER STRODE ROAD, CLEVEDON)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER No. 9 2011

The above Order, made on 12th May 2011, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert that part of Public Footpath LA 22/49 in the Parish of Clevedon within the District of North Somerset as described below, from:

point A (Grid Reference ST 39924 69395) running in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 226 metres to point D (Grid Reference ST 39808 69204), as shown by a continuous bold line on Map No. PPO 129.

to a footpath from point A (Grid Reference ST 39924 69395), running in a south easterly direction for approximately 30 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST 39936 69366), then in a south easterly direction for approximately 74 metres to a pedestrian gate at point F (Grid Reference ST 39965 69297) and then in a south easterly direction for approximately 31 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 39977 69268). The path then continues in a west, south westerly direction for approximately 156 metres to point C (Grid Reference ST 39843 69181) and then in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 44 metres to a pedestrian gate at point D (Grid Reference ST 39808 69204). The new path is shown by a bold broken line on the Order Map No. PPO 129 and will have a width of 2 metres.

The existing stiles at points A and E (on the proposed route, which the public have been using) will be removed and BS 5709.2006 compliant pedestrian gates will be provided at points F and D. References to points A, B, C, D, E and F above are references to the points on the Order Map No. PPO 129.

A copy of the Order and Order map has been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Reception desk, North Somerset Council Offices, Castlewood, Tickenham Road, Clevedon (opposite Clevedon Garages) from 9.00am to 4.30pm Mondays to Thursdays and 9.00am to 4.00pm Fridays, or may be viewed on the Council's Web site ([www.n-somerset.gov.uk/Your Council/Local Democracy/Public and Legal Notices](http://www.n-somerset.gov.uk/Your_Council/Local_Democracy/Public_and_Legal_Notices)). A copy is also available for inspection at Clevedon Library, 37 Old Church Road, Clevedon BS21 6NN during normal opening hours (9.30am to 5pm Mondays and Thursdays, 9.30am to 7pm Tuesdays and Fridays and 9.30am to 1pm and 2pm to 5pm on Saturdays [on first Thursday of each month, Library opens at 10am]).

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Director of Development and Environment, Natural Environment Team, Streets and Open Spaces, Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, BS23 1UJ not later than **17th June 2011** (quoting reference **PAP/PPO 129**). Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Somerset District Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER No. 9 2011

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council (“the authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of the Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The applicants have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Southfield Farm, Lower Strode Road, Clevedon and shown by a bold continuous line on the Map No. PPO 129 contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which North Somerset District Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highway mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. Notwithstanding this Order Western Power Distribution and British Telecommunications plc shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely: they shall for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they had immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted.
3. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situated at Southfield Farm, Lower Strode Road, Clevedon described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Map No. PPO 129 contained in this Order.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

That part of Public Footpath LA 22/49 in the Parish of Clevedon within the District of North Somerset from point A (Grid Reference ST 39924 69395) running in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 226 metres to point D (Grid Reference ST 39808 69204), as shown by a continuous bold line on Map No. PPO 129.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath from point A (Grid Reference ST 39924 69395), running in a south easterly direction for approximately 30 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST 39936 69366), then in a south easterly direction for approximately 74 metres to a pedestrian gate at point F (Grid Reference ST 39965 69297) and then in a south easterly direction for approximately 31 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 39977 69268). The path then continues in a west, south westerly direction for approximately 156 metres to point C (Grid Reference ST 39843 69181) and then in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 44 metres to a pedestrian gate at point D (Grid Reference ST 39808 69204). The new path is shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 129 and will have a width of 2 metres.

PART 3

LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS

Point F (Grid Reference ST 39965 69297)	Pedestrian Gate

The pedestrian gates specified above are to be provided to comply with BS 5709.2006 and should be considered for removal in the event that they are no longer required to prevent the ingress or egress of stock or if the land is no longer used for agricultural purposes.
