

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL **(FOOTPATH AX 16/44, PILHAY SLUICE, OFF A370, PUXTON)** **PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER No. 11 2011**

On 3rd November 2011 North Somerset District Council confirmed the above Order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert that part of Public Footpath AX 16/44 in the Parish of Puxton within the District of North Somerset as described below, from:

point A (Grid Reference ST 41594 64554) running in a north easterly direction for approximately 199 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 41672 64736) and then running in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 51 metres to point C (Grid Reference ST 41648 64779), as shown by a continuous bold line on Map No. PPO 127;

to a footpath from point A (Grid Reference ST 41594 64554), running in a generally north, north westerly direction for approximately 206 metres to a bridge at point D (Grid Reference ST 41568 64758), then running in a generally northerly direction for approximately 10 metres to a pedestrian gate at point E (Grid Reference ST 41572 64766) and then running in an east, north easterly direction for approximately 72 metres to a pedestrian gate at point F (Grid Reference ST 41643 64779). The path then runs in an easterly direction for approximately 6 metres to point C (Grid Reference ST 41648 64779).

The new path will have a width of 2 metres, apart from a 3 metre width where the route crosses the bridge between points D and E and is shown by a bold broken line on the Order Map No. PPO 127. The new path will have BS 5709.2006 compliant pedestrian gates at points E and F. References to points A, B, C, D, E and F above are references to the points on the Order Map No. PPO 127.

A copy of the Order and Order map has been placed and may be seen free of charge at Somerset House Reception, North Somerset Council, Oxford Street, Weston-super-Mare BS23 1TG from 9.00am to 4.30pm Monday to Thursday and to 4.00pm on Friday, or may be viewed on the Council's Web site ([www.n-somerset.gov.uk/Your Council/Local Democracy/Public and Legal Notices](http://www.n-somerset.gov.uk/Your_Council/Local_Democracy/Public_and_Legal_Notices)). A copy is also available for inspection at Congresbury Library, Station Road, Congresbury during normal opening hours (Monday 2.30pm to 5.30pm, Wednesday 10.00 to 1.00pm, Friday 10.00am to 1.00pm and 2.30pm to 5.30pm and Saturday 10.00am to 1.00pm. Please note, the library opens at 3pm on the 3rd Friday of each month.

The Order comes into force on 1st December 2011 but, if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 10th November 2011, make an application to the High Court.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL

(FOOTPATH AX 16/44, PILHAY SLUICE, OFF A370, PUXTON)

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER No. 11 2011

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council (“the authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of the Order and of the public it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The applicants have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Pilhay Sluice, off A370, Puxton and shown by a bold continuous line on the Map No. PPO 127 contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which North Somerset District Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highway mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situated at Pilhay Sluice, off A370, Puxton described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Map No. PPO 127 contained in this Order.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

That part of Public Footpath AX 16/44 in the Parish of Puxton within the District of North Somerset from point A (Grid Reference ST 41594 64554) running in a north easterly direction for approximately 199 metres to point B (Grid Reference ST 41672 64736) and then running in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 51 metres to point C (Grid Reference ST 41648 64779), as shown by a continuous bold line on Map No. PPO 127.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

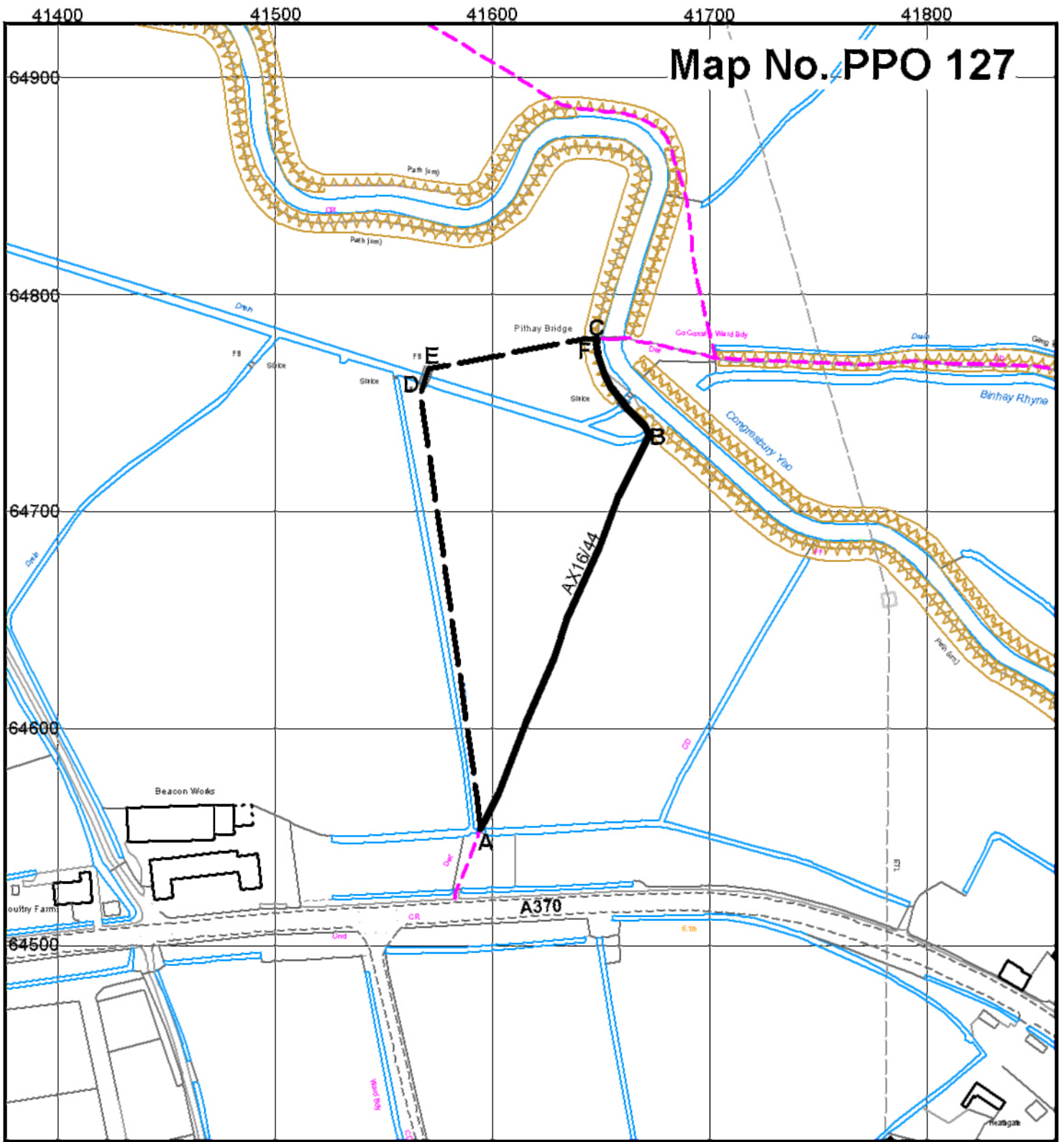
A footpath from point A (Grid Reference ST 41594 64554), running in a generally north, north westerly direction for approximately 206 metres to a bridge at point D (Grid Reference ST 41568 64758), then running in a generally northerly direction for approximately 10 metres to a pedestrian gate at point E (Grid Reference ST 41572 64766) and then running in an east, north easterly direction for approximately 72 metres to a pedestrian gate at point F (Grid Reference ST 41643 64779). The path then runs in an easterly direction for approximately 6 metres to point C (Grid Reference ST 41648 64779). The new path will have a width of 2 metres, apart from a 3 metre width where the route crosses the bridge between points D and E and is shown by a bold broken line on Map No. PPO 127.

LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS

Point E (Grid Reference ST 41572 64766)	Pedestrian Gate

The pedestrian gates specified above are to be provided to comply with BS 5709.2006 and should be considered for removal in the event that they are no longer required to prevent the ingress or egress of stock or if the land is no longer used for agricultural purposes.
