

**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

**NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL**

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER NO.5 2010**

**(PUBLIC FOOTPATHS LA 6/14 AND LA 6/15, 145/147 MAIN ROAD, CLEEVE**

The above Order, made on 19 November 2010, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert that part of Public Footpath LA 6/14 from point B (Grid Reference ST 46266 66491) running in a south easterly direction for approximately 100 metres to point D (Grid Reference ST 46306 66400) and also that part of Public Footpath LA 6/15 from point F (Grid Reference ST 46192 66510) running in a east, south easterly direction for approximately 110 metres to point C (Grid reference ST 46284 66451) both as shown by a bold continuous line on map No. PPO 102 to a new footpath from point B (Grid Reference ST 46266 66491) running in a south easterly direction for approximately 96 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST 46327 66417) and having a width varying between 1.2 metres and 1.6 metres and also a footpath from point F (Grid Reference ST 46192 66510) running in a north easterly direction for approximately 80 metres to point A (Grid Reference ST 46231 66578) at which point it will join Littlewood Lane. This path will be to a width of 2 metres. Both new footpaths are shown by bold broken line on Map No. PPO 102.

A new Kissing Gate will be provided at point B (Grid Reference ST 46266 66491) and new self closing Pedestrian gates at point G (Grid Reference ST 46289 66457) and point E (Grid Reference ST 46327 66417). All gates will be provide to BS 5709.2006)

References to points A,B,C,D,E,F and G above are references to the points on the Order Map no. PPO 102.

A copy of the Order and Order map has been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Reception Desk, Council Offices, Castlewood, Tickenham Road, Clevedon (opposite Clevedon Garages) from 9.00am to 4.30pm Monday to Thursday (4.00pm Friday) or may be viewed on the Council's Web site ([www.n-somerset.gov.uk](http://www.n-somerset.gov.uk) / Your Council / Local Democracy / Public and Legal Notices). A copy is also available for inspection at Yatton Library, 48 High Street, Yatton during normal opening hours (Monday, Tuesday and Friday 9.00am to 6.00pm, Thursday 10.00am to 8.00pm and Saturday 9.00am to 1.00pm).

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Director of Development and Environment, Natural Environment Team, Streets and Open Spaces, Town Hall, Walliscote Road, Weston-super-Mare, BS23 1UJ not later than **Monday 24 January 2011** (Quoting Reference MJB/PPO 102). Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Somerset District Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER NO.5 2010**

**FOOTPATHS LA 6/14 and LA 6/15, 145/147 MAIN ROAD, CLEEVE**

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council (“the authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of 145 and 147 Main Road, Cleeve, it is expedient that the line of the footpath should be diverted.

North Somerset District Council has agreed to contribute towards any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER :

1. The public rights of way over the land situate at nos. 145 and 147 Main Road, Cleeve and shown by a bold continuous line on the map no. PPO 102 contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date on which North Somerset District Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highway mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. Notwithstanding this order Western Power Distribution and British Telecommunications plc shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely : they shall for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they had immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted.
3. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate adjacent to 147 Main Road, Cleeve described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map no. PPO 102 contained in this Order.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

## **SCHEDULE**

### **PART 1**

#### **DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY**

That part of Public Footpath LA 6/14 from point B (Grid Reference ST 46266 66491) running in a south easterly direction for approximately 100 metres to point D (Grid Reference ST 46306 66400)

Also that part of Public Footpath LA 6/15 from point F (Grid Reference ST 46192 66510) running in a east, south easterly direction for approximately 110 metres to point C (Grid reference ST 46284 66451) both as shown by a bold continuous line on map No. PPO 102.

### **PART 2**

#### **DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY**

##### **Footpath LA 6/14**

A footpath from point B (Grid Reference ST 46266 66491) running in a south easterly direction for approximately 96 metres to point E (Grid Reference ST 46327 66417) as shown by bold broken line on Map No. PPO 102. This path will vary in width between 1.2 metres and 1.6 metres.

##### **Footpath LA 6/15**

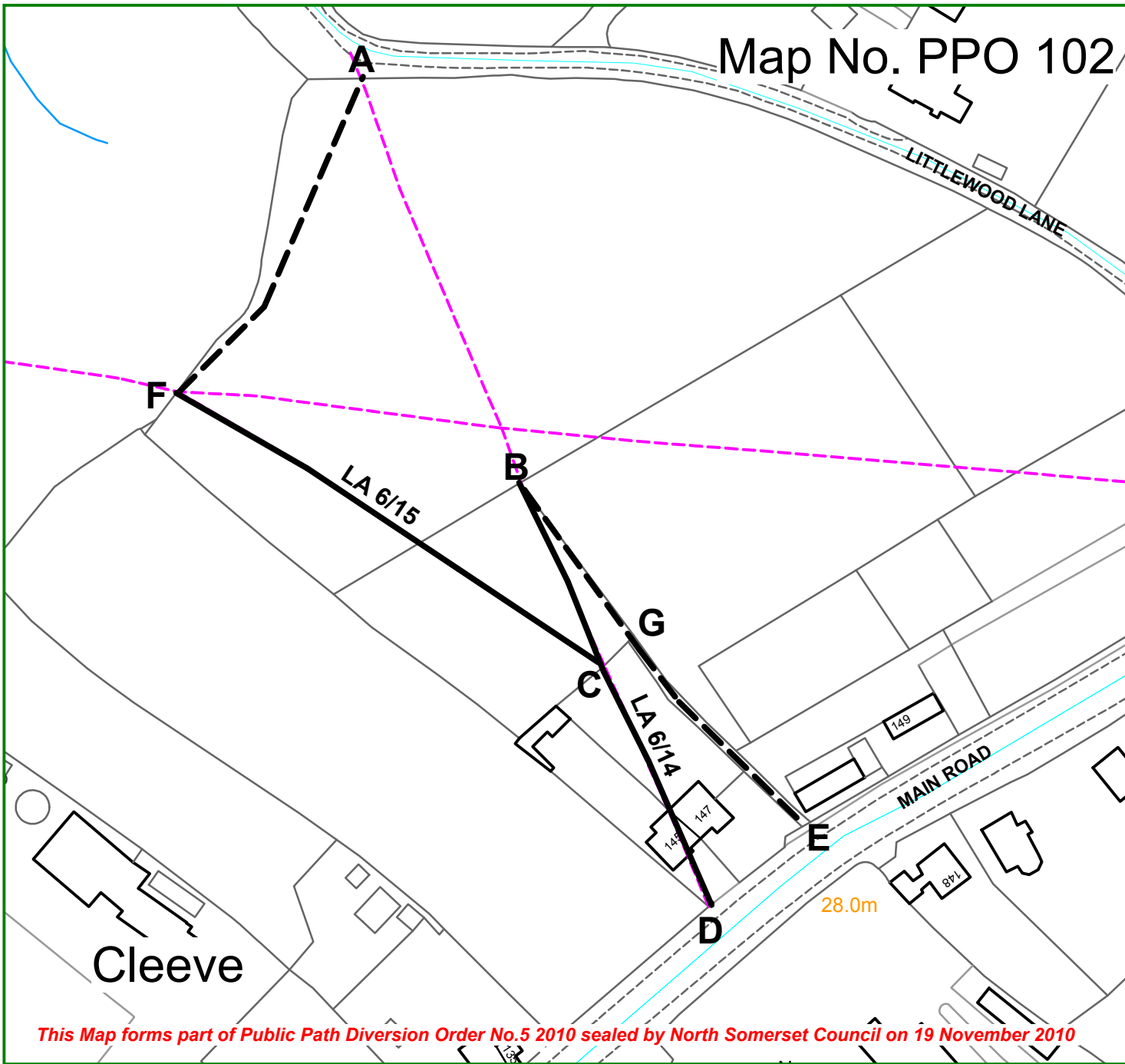
A footpath from point F (Grid Reference ST 46192 66510) running in a north easterly direction for approximately 80 metres to point A (Grid Reference ST 46231 66578) at which point it will join Littlewood Lane as shown by bold broken line on Map No. PPO 102. This path will be to a width of 2 metres.

### **PART 3**

#### **LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS**

Point B (Grid Reference ST 46266 66491)	Kissing Gate
Point G (Grid Reference ST 46289 66457)	Self Closing one way Pedestrian Gate
Point E (Grid Reference ST 46327 66417)	Self Closing one way Pedestrian Gate

The Gates specified above are to be provided to comply with BS 5709.2006 and should be considered for removal in the event that they are no longer required to prevent the ingress or egress of stock or if the land is no longer used for agricultural purposes.

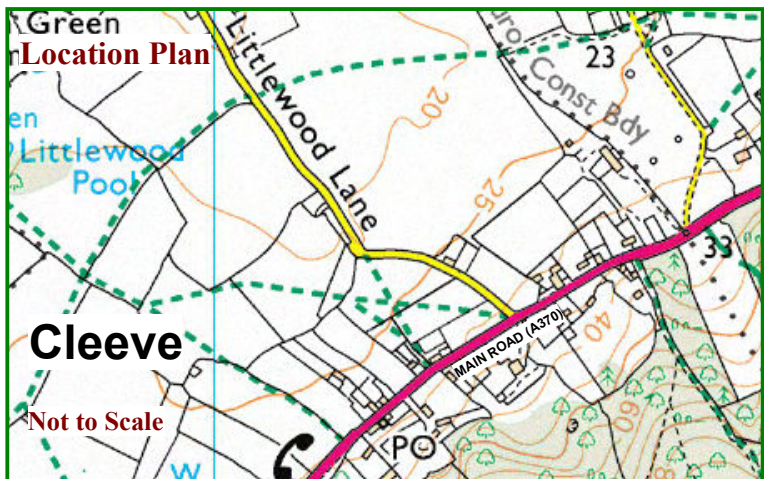
