

**Notice of confirmation of an Order

On 7 March 2019 North Somerset Council ('NSC') confirmed the above Order, made under section 119, Highways Act 1980. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert that part of Public Footpath AX 30/71 in Wrington Parish, within the District of North Somerset as described below:

From point A (grid ref. ST 47273 64273) at Wrington Hill, running in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 74m, to point B (grid ref. ST 47334 64314); to a footpath from the existing metal field gate at point D (grid ref. ST 47266 64279) running in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 58m, to a new metal field gate at point C and then running in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 18m to point B, as shown on Order Map No. PPO 179. The 2m wide path will have a pasture surface.
