**Date coming into force: 21 October 2019**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Truespeed Communications Ltd to undertake testing and clearing of BT ducts. This will become operative on **21 October 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **12 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

**Schedule** - Ladymead Lane from its junction with A38 Bristol Road for approximately 646m to its junction with Pudding Pie Lane. **Alternative routes** see <https://northsomerset.roadworks.org/>

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by West-Tec Construction to enable scaffolding and safe access for development works. This will become operative on **13 October 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of approximately **325 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

**Schedule** - Old Post Office Lane for its full extent (access maintained). **Alternative routes** – as signs dictate.
