Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order No 5 2019

The above order made on 27 September 2019 if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding an unrecorded route onto the Definitive Map for the area as Restricted Byway LA 21/46 and LA 10/8. The route A-B-C-D commences at the junction of the adopted highway known as Claverham Drove, Point A, in the Parish of Yatton and proceeds in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 237 metres to Point B where it then passes into the Parish of Kenn. This section of the route will be known as Restricted Byway LA 21/46. The route then continues from Point B for a further distance of approximately 1510 metres to Point C and proceeds in a westerly direction for a further distance of approximately 395 metres to Point D terminating at the junction of adopted highway known as Kennmoor Road. This section of the route will be known as Restricted Byway LA 10/8.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, North Somerset Council, instead of submitting the order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the order (or that part of the Order). If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
