Personal Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aged 21 years or over • Able to make a minimum commitment of 2 hours per week for a minimum of 12 months. • Have access to own transport or be able to travel around North Somerset. • Make a commitment to attend individual and group supervision as specified. • Make a commitment to complete initial training and ongoing training. • If applicant has a history of substance misuse, must demonstrate a minimum of 5 years of abstinence. • If applicant has any criminal conviction they must be willing to disclose full details to staff. All convictions also need to be spent with a minimum of 5 years since last offence
