North Somerset District Council ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33, 34 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 and 35C of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the 1984 Act') and Under the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the 2004 Act) and of all other enabling powers makes the following order :-

**PART 1 – GENERAL**

**Commencement**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the \*DATE\* and may be cited as the "North Somerset District Council, Ashton Court Estate, Long Ashton (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 20\*\*".

**Interpretation**

2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings respectively assigned to them:-

'Approved Method of Payment' means 'pay by phone' or by credit or debit card facilitated by remote verification or by pre-payment card;

'Calendar Day' means a day starting at 00.00 hours and ending at 23.59 hours

'Caravan' means a touring or other caravan designed to be towed by a motor vehicle and excludes a motor home

'Charging Hours' means the period of time specified in column 5 of schedule 2

'Civil Enforcement Officer' has the meaning assigned to it in section 76 of the 2004 Act

‘Credit Card’ and ‘Debit Card’ mean methods of payment at such parking places as the Landowner may from time to time nominate and involve use of a valid credit or debit card which is accepted by the Landowner as a valid method of payment at the time of use of the parking place;

‘Disabled Person’s Badge’ had the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

‘Driver’ in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

‘Free Zone’ means those parking bays or areas within a parking place marked as such by signs or surface markings and includes pick up and drop off areas and loading bays;

‘Goods Vehicle’ means any vehicle with a design gross weight which exceeds 3,500 kilograms;

‘Hackney Carriage’ has the meaning assigned to it by section 38 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847;

‘Landowner’ means Bristol City Council, City Hall, PO Box 3399, Bristol, BS1 1NE

‘Motor Car’ has the meaning assigned to it by section 136(2) of ‘the Act’

‘Motor Cycle’ means a solo motor cycle only and excludes a motor cycle which has a side car or trailer or which has more than two wheels;

‘Motor Home’ means a motor vehicle designed to serve as self-contained living quarters for recreational travel

‘Overflow parking area’ means an area of land authorised by this order as identified on Part II of Schedule 1 to this order for the leaving of a vehicle and as made available from time to time by notice displayed at the overflow parking area;

‘Parking Bay’ means any area of the parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle and indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place;

‘Parking Place’ means any area of land specified by name in column 1 of Schedule 2 provided by the Council under Section 33(4)(b) of the Act for use as a parking place;

‘Parking Ticket’ means a ticket issued by a ticket machine on payment of a charge and valid for the initial period;

‘Pay and Display machine’ for the purpose of this order means apparatus used in connection with the operation of a parking place or overflow parking area and which is designed to indicate the time by a clock and to issue numbered tickets indication one or more of the following:-

- a) The date of issue;
- b) The payment of a parking charge;
- c) The departure time; and
- d) Other information relating to the leaving of a vehicle in a pay and display parking bay or in an overflow parking area.

‘Pay and Display Parking Place’ means any Parking Place in or at which a Ticket Machine/s are installed

‘Pay by Phone’ means a method of payment of the initial charge involving registration of payment by phone or electronic means and on first use registration of the relevant registration number of the vehicle, location of the Parking Place, Credit or Debit Card details or any other such details as the Landowner may from time to time require which is accepted by the Landowner as a valid method of payment at the time of use of the Parking Place;

‘Permit’ means a document issued by the Council, the Landowner or the Golf Hub, Ashton Court with or without charge, in accordance with Article 24 below;

‘Person Responsible’ for the purposes of any contravention of or non-compliance with this Order is the driver of the vehicle;

‘Public Service Vehicle’ has the meaning assigned to it by section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981

‘Trailer’ has the meaning assigned to it by section 136(1) of the Act

‘Virtual ticket or virtual permit’ means a ticket or permit purchased via the Landowner approved parking app or online payment system.

Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.

- (2) For the purpose of this Order, a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a Disabled Person's Badge, Permit or a Parking Ticket in the ‘relevant position’ when:-

- (a) the Disabled Persons Badge, Permit or Parking Ticket is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
  - (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia the Disabled Person's Badge, Permit or Parking Ticket is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle, so that the front of the Disabled Person's Badge, Permit or Parking Ticket is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle, or
  - (c) the Disabled persons Badge, Permit or Parking Ticket is attached to the windscreen such that the Disabled Person's Badge, Permit or Parking Ticket is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle
- (3) For the purposes of the Order 'Classes of Vehicle' are:
- (a) Motor Cars
  - (b) Motor Cycles
  - (c) Hackney Carriages
  - (d) Public Service Vehicles
  - (e) Goods Vehicles under 3,500 kg
  - (f) Motor Homes under 3,500 kg
  - (g) Vehicles displaying Valid Permits
  - (h) Vehicles displaying a Disabled Persons Badge

3. Article, Schedule and other headings shall not affect the interpretation of this Order

4. The Schedules form part of this Order and shall have effect as if set out in full in the body of this Order. Any reference to this Order includes the Schedules.

5. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament unless otherwise stated.

## **PART II – AUTHORISATION AND USE OF PARKING PLACES**

### **Authorisation**

6. Each Parking Place referred to in Column 1 of Schedule 2 and identified in the plans referred to by number in column 2 of Schedule 2 and attached to this Order may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as a place to leave vehicles of such classes, in such positions, on such days, during such hours, for such period of such payment of such charges as are specified in relation thereto in the Order

### **Class and Position of Vehicles**

7. Where column 3 of schedule 2 to this Order provides that a Parking Place is available for use by vehicles of a specified class or for vehicles of a specified class to be left in a specified location or where signed and marked in any Parking Bay, no person shall permit a vehicle to wait in that Parking Place or any Parking Bay:
- (i) unless it is of the specified class appropriate to that Parking Bay;
  - (ii) unless it is wholly within a marked Parking Bay;
  - (iii) in a position other than that specified;
  - (iv) in any access road forming part of the Parking Place

### **Express Permission of the Council or Landowner**

8. A person duly authorised by the Council or Landowner may give permission for a vehicle to be left in a Parking Place or marked area within a Parking Place without displaying a Parking Ticket or Permit. There shall be no requirement for such permission to be given in writing to the Driver of the vehicle.

### **Maximum Period of Stay**

9. N/a

### **Period of No Return**

10. n/a

### **Disabled Persons Parking Bays**

11. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to park in a Parking Bay marked for disabled persons unless the vehicle is displaying a Disabled Person's Badge and has been or is about to be used by the person in respect of whom the Disabled Person's Badge has been issued

### **Additional Time for Driver's of Vehicles Displaying a Disabled Person's Badge**

12. Drivers of vehicles displaying a Disabled Person's Badge (regardless of whether the vehicle is left in a Disabled Persons Parking Bay) shall be entitled to leave the vehicle in a Parking Place specified in column 1 of schedules 4 and 5 for an additional period of time specified in column 2 of schedules 4 and 5 in excess of;

- (i) any period of maximum stay as specified in Article 9 and column 6 of schedule 2, and
- (ii) any time specified on a Parking Ticket issued by a Ticket Machine
- (iii) any expiry time on a virtual ticket purchased via a recognised approved method of payment, as laid out in Section 2 of this order

### **Power to close or suspend Parking Places**

13. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Landowner by notice, sign or barrier displayed in the Parking Place;

- (i) from closing the Parking Place or any part thereof for any period; and / or
- (ii) from setting aside the Parking Place or any part or parts thereof on all days or on certain days or during parts of days for use only by certain vehicles, persons or

14. Where the Landowner suspends use of a Parking Place or any part thereof in accordance with Article 13 above, it shall cause to be placed in or adjacent to that Parking Place or that part thereof a notice or sign indicating that the use of that Parking Place or part thereof is suspended and that waiting by vehicles is prohibited

15. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in a Parking Place or any part thereof during such periods that the use of that Parking Place or part thereof is suspended or during such period as there is in or adjacent thereto a notice or sign placed by or on behalf of the Landowner in accordance with Article 9 above

### **PART III CHARGES FOR PARKING**

#### **Payment**

16. The Driver of a vehicle waiting in a Parking Place shall upon arriving in that Parking Place pay the appropriate charge (if any) in accordance with the scale of charges specified in column 9 of schedule 2 to this Order

#### **Pay and Display Parking Places**

17. The Driver of a vehicle using a pay and display Parking Place shall upon arriving in the Parking Place;
- (i) obtain a Parking Ticket from a Ticket Machine situated in that Parking Place, or
  - (ii) make arrangement to pay the appropriate fee through an Approved Method of Payment
18. Where the Driver of a vehicle is required by any sign or notice displayed in a Parking Place to obtain and display a Parking Ticket in respect of any period during which a vehicle may wait in the Parking Place free of charge, such Parking Ticket shall be obtained from the Ticket Machine immediately on arriving in the Parking Place

#### **Display of Ticket in Pay and Display Parking Places**

19. On obtaining a Parking Ticket, the Driver of the vehicle shall;
- (i) display the Parking Ticket in the relevant position in accordance with Article 2(2) of the Order, and
  - (ii) ensure that the Parking Ticket is continuously displayed throughout the entire period that the vehicle is waiting in the Parking Place

#### **Validity of Parking Tickets**

20. A Parking Ticket is not transferrable from one vehicle to another
21. A Parking Ticket is only valid in the Parking Place in which it was issued



### **Failure to Display Parking Tickets**

22. Save as provided by Part IV below; if at any time while a vehicle is waiting in a Parking Place no Parking Ticket is displayed in the relevant position, or the Parking Ticket has expired and confirmation of non-payment or expiry of time purchased by an Alternative Method of Payment is achieved by the Civil Enforcement Officer, it shall be deemed that a contravention of this Order has occurred

### **Ticket Machines**

23. If at the time when a vehicle is waiting during that Charging Hours in a Parking Place, a Ticket Machine in that Parking Place is out of order; the driver of the vehicle shall obtain a Parking Ticket from an alternative Ticket Machine in that Parking Place or purchase a virtual ticket via an Alternative Method of Payment.

### **Parking Permits**

24. Permits may be issued by the Council, the Landowner or Ashton Court Golf Hub. Such permits are valid;
- (i) in such Parking Place or Parking Places as specified on the Permit;
  - (ii) on such day or days as specified on the Permit
  - (iii) on such hours as specified on the Permit, if any
  - (iv) up to and including the expiry date specified on the Permit
  - (v) unless cancelled by the Council, the Landowner or Ashton Court Golf Hub
25. Where a Permit is issued in respect of a particular vehicle, identified by the registration number of the vehicle specified on the Permit; such permit shall only be valid in respect of and when displayed in the vehicle in respect of which it was issued
26. The Driver of the vehicle shall;
- (i) display the Permit in the relevant position in accordance with Article 2(2) of the Order, and
  - (ii) ensure that the Permit is continuously displayed throughout the entire period that the vehicle is waiting in the Parking Place

**PART IV  
EXEMPTIONS AND DISPENSATIONS**

**Exemptions from Daily Charges**

27. No daily charge shall be payable in respect of a vehicle waiting in a Parking Place;
- (i) displaying in the relevant position a Permit valid for that day and time, for that Parking Place and which has not expired
  - (ii) Motor Cycles left in marked motor cycle bays
  - (iii) with express permission of the Landowner, pursuant to Article 8, above

**Exemption where Ticket Machines Out of Order**

28. Where no Parking Ticket can be obtained and displayed by reason that all Ticket Machines in the Parking Place are out of order and that no alternative Approved method of Payment is available, drivers of vehicles left in the Parking Place shall be exempt from the requirement in Article 17 above to purchase a Parking Ticket, provided that vehicles may not wait for longer than the maximum period of waiting in that Parking Place as specified in column 6 of schedule 2 to this Order or 24 hours whichever is the shorter

**Exemption from the Requirement to Display a Parking Ticket or Permit**

29. Where arrangement has been made to pay the charge specified in Article 16 by an Approved Method of Payment and no Parking Ticket is produced by following the process, the Driver of a vehicle shall be exempt from the requirement to display such a ticket
30. Where a person authorised by the Landowner has given permission for a vehicle to wait in a Parking Place pursuant to Article 8 above, and no Parking Ticket or Permit is produced, the Driver of the vehicle shall be exempt from the requirement to display such a Parking Ticket or Permit

**Exemption from Time Limit**

31. N/A

### **Free Zones**

32. Where within a Parking Place there are signs or surface markings indicating that waiting within a marked area or Parking Bay is free of charge, a vehicle shall be permitted to wait free of charge at the location as specified in column 1 of schedule 7 and shall not be permitted to return to the Free Zone within that Parking Place for the period specified in column 2 of schedule 7

### **Dispensations for Drivers Displaying Disabled Person's Badge**

33. Drivers of vehicles displaying a Disabled Persons Badge waiting in the Parking Places specified in column 1 of schedule 4 to this Order shall not be in contravention of this Order by reason that the Parking Ticket on display has expired, provided that the Parking Ticket has expired by a period not exceeding the period of time specified in column 2 of schedule 4 to this Order

34. Drivers of vehicles displaying a Disabled Persons Badge waiting in the Parking Places specified in column 1 of schedule 5 shall not be in contravention of this Order by reason that the vehicle has been left in the Parking Place for longer than that maximum period of stay, provided that the maximum period of stay has been exceeded by not more than the period of time specified in column 2 of schedule 5

## **PART V OTHER PROVISIONS**

### **Stop Engine**

35. The Driver of a vehicle using a Parking Place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in the Parking Bay and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place

### **Vehicle Tax and Insurance**

36. No person shall permit any vehicle to wait in a Parking Place:

- (i) unless the vehicle has a current licence issued in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994
- (ii) unless there is in relation to the use of the vehicle by the Driver such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act 1988

### **Entry and Exit**

37. Where signs erected or surface marking are laid for the purpose of indicating the entrances to or exits from the parking place; or indicating a vehicle is to proceed in a specified direction, no person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle;
- (i) so that it enters the Parking Place otherwise than by an entrance, or leaves the Parking Place otherwise than by an exit;
  - (ii) in a direction other than that specified;
  - (iii) in a manner or at a speed so as to cause a danger to other users of the Parking Place
- 37a. A Civil Enforcement Officer or other person authorised by the Council, or the Landowner, or a police officer in uniform may ask the driver of any vehicle to leave a parking place at any time should they feel/believe the vehicle is being driven in a dangerous fashion so as to be likely to cause injury or nuisance to others. No refund of any parking charges paid will be available should a vehicle be asked to leave the parking place.

### **Use of a Vehicle and Parking Places**

38. No person shall in a parking place:
- (i) without the express written permission of the Landowner, use a vehicle in connection with the sale of any article, including the vehicle itself, to any person in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of skill or services in any other capacity;
  - (ii) use a vehicle in connection with the sale of any article unless so doing as part of a market, the existence of which has been authorised by the Landowner;
  - (iii) sound any horn or similar instrument except to warn other persons of imminent danger
  - (iv) except with the permission or at the direction of a Civil Enforcement Officer or other person authorised by the Council or the Landowner or a police officer in uniform, drive any vehicle other than for the purpose of leaving the vehicle in the Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of this Order, or for the purpose of leaving the Parking Place, or for the purpose of visiting any amenity site in the parking place or as a necessary means of access
  - (v) without express permission of the Landowner, use any part of the Parking Place or any vehicle in the Parking Place for;
    - a) sleeping or camping purposes
    - b) cooking purposes
  - (vi) without the express written permission of the Landowner, use any part of the Parking Place or any vehicle in the Parking Place for the purpose of washing, valeting or servicing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable the vehicle to depart the Parking Place
  - (vii) without the express written permission of the Landowner, carry out or permit the carrying out of any work or maintenance or repair to a vehicle except such as may be necessary to enable to vehicle to be moved from the Parking Place
  - (viii) use a Parking Place solely as a means of passage proceeding from one road to another

- (ix) wantonly shout or otherwise make any noise to cause disturbance or annoyance to users of the Parking Place, residents or other occupiers of nearby premises
- (x) deposit or leave any vehicle, trailer, or anything which formed part of a vehicle or trailer, or any rubbish, litter or any other material whether by dumping or fly posting with the purpose of abandoning it there
- (xi) act in a manner to cause nuisance, harassment, alarm or distress to any Parking Place user, resident or other person
- (xii) without express written permission of the Landowner; erect or cause to be erected any tent, booth, stand or other structure
- (xiii) without express permission of the Landowner leave a Caravan
- (xiv) light or cause to be lit any fire
- (xv) except with the express written permission of the Landowner, distribute leaflets or other advertising material or promote any cause, event or any other matter

### **Liability**

- 39. The Council or Landowner accepts no liability for the loss or damage to vehicles or other property left in any Parking Place
- 40. The Council or Landowner accepts no liability for injury occurring within any Parking Place save where such injury is attributable to the negligence of the Landowner.
- 41. This Order is enforced via a service level agreement with the Landowner, Bristol City Council.

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The Council proposes to make an off-street parking Order to introduce Pay and Display Parking charges within Ashton Court Estate car parks; Mansion House, Golf Hub & Church Lodge.

Bristol City Council is developing proposals to make its Heritage Estates more attractive places to visit by hosting more temporary and permanent events and activities in forthcoming years. It is anticipated that future initiatives to attract more visitors to Bristol's Heritage Estates will increase parking demand and in turn necessitate parking enforcement to ensure turnover of spaces, and maximisation of parking opportunity is available to everyone visiting Bristol's Heritage Estates.

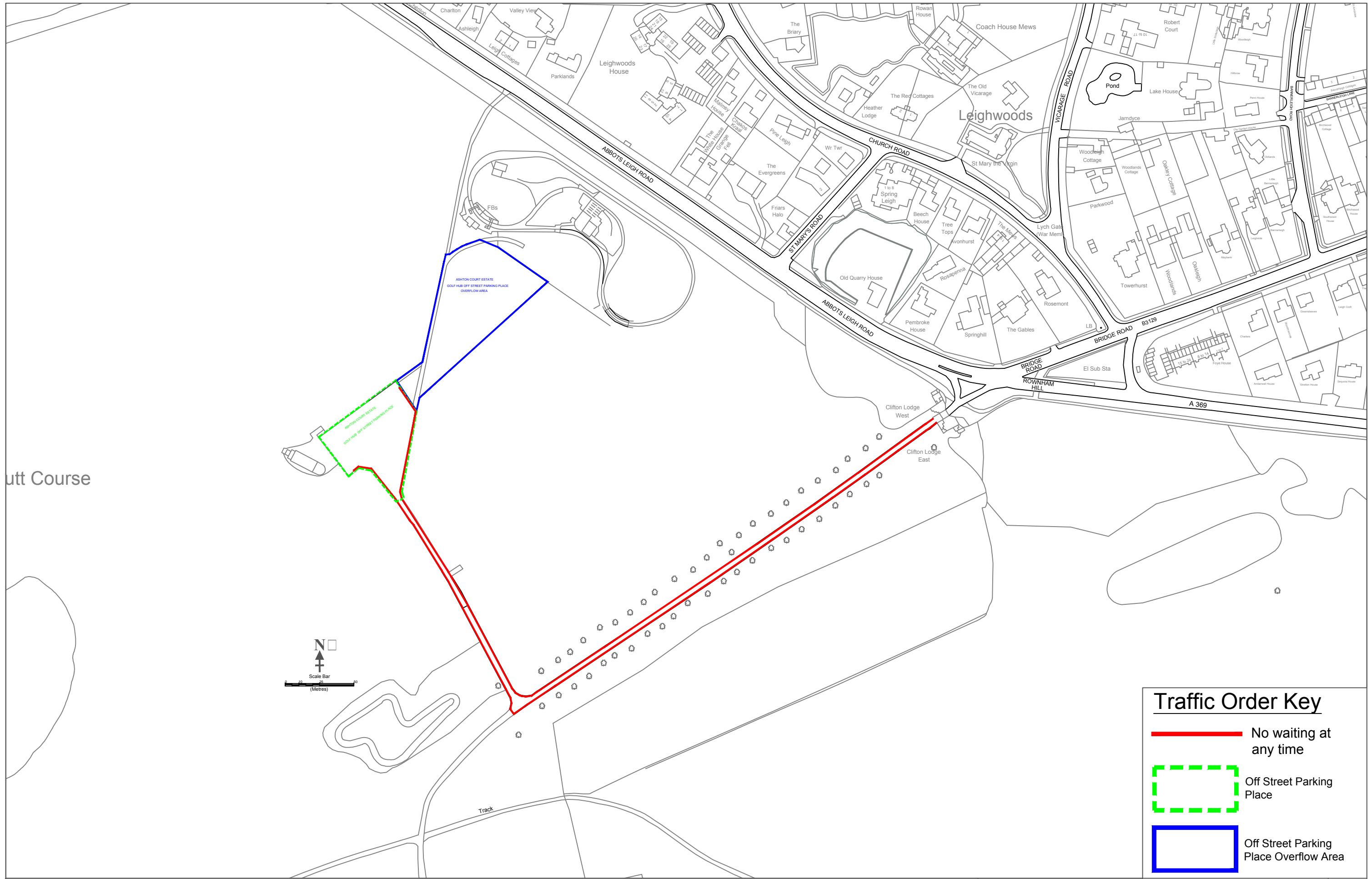

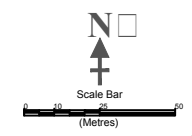
The proposed Parking Order is considered appropriate for the purpose of improving open land to which the general public has access.

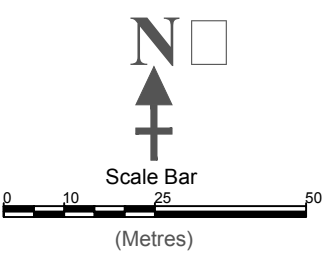
