(VARIOUS ROADS, LEIGH WOODS AREA)
(NO WAITING AT ANY TIME) (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2016

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 9th September 2016 the District Council of North Somerset made an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended the effect of which is, for a maximum period of eighteen months, to **prohibit any vehicle waiting at any time (double yellow lines) in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice**. This Order will come into operation on 19th September 2016.

Full details of the Experimental Order, together with a map, and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the order may be inspected at the following locations:

SCHEDULE
(No waiting at any time)

BRIDGE ROAD

North side

- between Church Road and Bannerleigh Road (approx. 140 metres)
- from Bannerleigh Road to the existing parking restrictions near North Road (approx. 150 metres)

BRIDGE ROAD

South side

- between the slip-road to Rownham Hill and (including) the western vehicle entrance to Foye House (approx. 35 metres)
- across the vehicle entrances to:
 - o Foye House (eastern)
 - o Charters & Woodmancote (combined restriction)
 - o Greensleeves
 - o Leigh Croft & The Orchard (combined restriction)
 - o Lingfield (western entrance)
 - o Lingfield (eastern entrance) & Milton Lodge (combined restriction)
 - o Kingston Lodge
 - o Kingston Cottage
- between Kingston Cottage and the existing parking restrictions near Burwalls Road (approx. 40 metres)

NORTH ROAD

West side

- between the existing parking restrictions near Bridge Road and (including) the entrance to Grant House.
- Approximately 5 metres either side of the junction with Broad Oaks.
- Approximately 50 metres around the inside of the bend adjacent to Telford House, starting from a point approximately 75 metres north of the entrance to Broad Oaks.

NORTH ROAD

East side

- from the existing parking restrictions near Bridge Road to a point opposite the entrance to Telford House (approx. 210 metres).
