

# NOTICE OF INTENT

## NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL

### (A4174 SOUTH BRISTOL LINK AND A38 BRIDGWATER ROAD) (24 HOUR CLEARWAY AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (VARIATION) ORDER 201#

Notice is HEREBY GIVEN that North Somerset District Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) propose to make an Order under sections 1(1), 2, 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and 122 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

The general effect of the proposed Order is to amend the previously advertised Clearway restriction on the full length of the proposed A4174 South Bristol Link between its junction with the A370 Long Ashton Bypass and the district boundary with Bristol City at Highridge Common. **The amendment provides additional exemptions to the Clearway restrictions for railway undertakers to facilitate maintenance and improvement works to railway infrastructure.**
