

Decision statement

Claverham Neighbourhood Plan

North Somerset Council Executive on 24 October 2017 resolved that the Claverham Neighbourhood Plan with examiners modifications meets the necessary basic conditions and complies with the provision made by or under section 38A and 38B of the 2004 Act as below.

(Extract from minute EXE37 Claverham neighbourhood Plan Agenda Item11))

Resolved:

(1) that the modifications set out in the appendix to the report be accepted and the Executive resolve that the Claverham Neighbourhood Plan, with those modifications, meets the basic conditions, is compatible with the Convention rights, and complies with the definition of a neighbourhood development plan, and should therefore proceed to referendum, the referendum area to be the Claverham Neighbourhood Plan area; and

(2) that the Director of Development and Environment be authorised to make the necessary arrangements for the Claverham Neighbourhood Development Plan referendum.
