

**Walliscote Road, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2019
Ref: RS/T19/01**

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which has closed, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

This order was required because of works for carriageway resurfacing and will become operative on the **7 January 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of **5 days** in duration.

Alternative routes - North to South (Walliscote Grove Road, Carlton Street, Beach Road and vice versa), West to East (Clevedon Road junction) – Beach Road, Uphill Road North, Windwhistle Road, Devonshire Road, Drove Road, Brighton Road and vice versa. **Schedule** – Walliscote Road - Clevedon Road to Clarence Road North

Temporary 30mph Speed Limit Order 2019
Date coming into force: 28 January 2019
Ref:T19-31**

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict the speed of any vehicle from not exceeding 30mph in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Wales & West Utilities Ltd to replace a gas pipe. This will become operative on **28 January 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the restriction may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of **75 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Gigaclear Limited to install fibre optic equipment. This will become operative on **3 February 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works in two phases which is anticipated to be **2 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Gigaclear Limited to undertake installation of Fibre Optic equipment. This will become operative on **21 January 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works in two phases which is anticipated to be **6 days** in duration for Phase One and **1 day** in duration for Phase Two anticipated to start **27 January 2019**. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.
