Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order  
Searle Crescent/Winterstoke Road, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset  
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2019  
Ref: MOS/T19/22**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

**This order** is required because of works to create a right turn from Searle Crescent onto Winterstoke Road and associated works and will become operative on **11 March 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures will not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which will require several closures over a period anticipated to be **2 weeks** in duration.

**Alternative routes** – Searle Crescent: Phillips Road, Searle Crescent, Herluin Way, Winterstoke Roundabout. Winterstoke Road: Marchfields Way, Marchfields Way Roundabout, Winterstoke Road. **Schedule:** Searle Crescent from Phillips Road to Winterstoke Road. Winterstoke Road from Winterstoke Roundabout to Searle Crescent.

**Notice of Construction of speed cushion road humps on Winterstoke Road, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset**  
**Ref: MOS/T19-22/CUSHIONS**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in exercise of the powers conferred by section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 (hereinafter called 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with section 90C (1) of the Act and those bodies or persons prescribed by the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 (hereinafter called 'the Regulations') and in accordance with section 90C (2) of the Act intends to construct speed cushion road humps at the locations specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The general effect of the notice will be to construct speed cushion road humps on Winterstoke Road at the following locations: two speed cushions on Winterstoke Road near Searle Crescent junction, grid ref: 333244,160519. The speed cushion road hump measurements will be 2m long by 1.8m wide and no more than 75mm in height, subject to the permitted tolerances.
