Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of Section 14 & Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule One to this Notice. To temporarily prohibit the use by pedestrians, cyclists and horse riders in the various footpaths and bridleways as specified in the Schedule Two of this Notice. To implement temporarily one-way traffic working in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule Three. To temporarily suspend the existing speed limit in favour of restricting temporarily any vehicle to 20MPH in the lengths of road specified in Schedule Four to this notice. Exemptions for association with the event and authorised to do so under the direction of the event organiser and (a) a vehicle used by the fire brigade, police authority, or local authority for their respective purposes (b) an ambulance (c) a vehicle used by an Undertaker as defined in Part III of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (d) a vehicle authorised in particular circumstances or for particular purposes by a police constable, a civil enforcement officer, a police community support officer, an official steward or marshal under the direction of the event organisers or (e) a vehicle which displays in a conspicuous position a written authorisation given by North Somerset Council or event organisers.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger and a requirement for safety to the public and participants due to the Weston Super Half Marathon 2019 (referred to as the 'Event'). This shall come into force on **24 March 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months for the Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles, Temporary One Way and Temporary 20MPH Speed Limit. For a maximum period of 6 months for the Temporary Prohibition of use by pedestrians, cyclists and horse riders. However, the closures and restrictions may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the event which is anticipated to be **1 day** from 7am to 2pm in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule one - Richmond Street from its junction with St James Street to its junction with Marine Parade. Uphill Road South from its junction with Uphill Way to its junction with Bridgwater Road (A370). Kewstoke Road from Upper Kewstoke Road to its junction with Beach Road, Kewstoke. Beach Road from its junction with Oxford Street to its junction with Salisbury Terrace. Regent Street from its junction with Marine Parade to its junction with York Street. Accommodation Road from its junction with A370 Bridgwater Road to Wayacre Drove. The following roads for their entire length: Links Road, Beach Road, Uphill Way, Royal Parade, Birnbeck Road, Birkett Road, Upper Kewstoke Road (part unadopted). Not adopted highway for their entire length. Marine Parade, Wayacre Drove, Upper Kewstoke Road (part adopted).

Not adopted highway. Seafront Promenade from the junction with Regent Street/Grand Pier to Manilla Crescent. **Schedule two** - All listed for the entire length: AX6/1, AX6/4, AX6/5 Bridleways. AX31/2a, AX31/3, AX31/4, AX31/5. CYCLE WAY 33 (not Public Right of Way). Weston to Brean Cycle Way - from Uphill Marine Centre in a southerly direction to AX6/5 Bridleway. **Schedule three** - Bridgwater Road (A370) at its junction with Accommodation Road in a northerly direction to its junction with Uphill Road South. **Schedule four** - Bridgwater Road (A370) at its junction with Accommodation Road the speed restriction commences for 1350m in a northerly direction and continues to its junction with Uphill Road South in association with a lane closure. **Alternative routes** - appropriate signage will be displayed to facilitate the diversion route whilst closures are in place required for the event.
