

NOTICE OF POLL AND SITUATION OF POLLING STATIONS

Referendum on the Neighbourhood Plan for Yatton

1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday 11 April 2019** to decide on the question below:

Do you want North Somerset Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Yatton to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?

2. The hours of poll will be from 7am to 10pm.
3. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, BS23 1UJ by 5pm on Wednesday 3 April 2019.
4. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, Somerset, BS23 1UJ by 5pm on Thursday 11 April 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 3 April 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 3 April 2019.
5. The situation of polling stations and the description of persons entitled to vote thereat are as follows:
