Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Gigaclear Limited to install fibre optic ducting. This will become operative on **9 May 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **5 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Weston Lane from its junction with Christon Road for approximately 30m in a northerly direction. **Alternative routes** – no suitable route.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Wales & West Utilities Ltd to upgrade gas mains. This will become operative on **13 May 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works in two phases which is anticipated to be **5 weeks** in duration in Phase One, anticipated to commence **13 May 2019** and anticipated to be **7 weeks** in Phase Two anticipated to commence **3 June 2019**. The timings of the phases are subject to completion of earlier phase permitting Phase Two to begin earlier or in the event of encountering engineering difficulties subsequent phase may be delayed. Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in Schedule One and to temporarily implement waiting and loading restrictions in the roads specified in Schedule Two to this Notice. Exemptions for association with the event and authorised to do so under the direction of the event organiser and (a) a vehicle used by the fire brigade, police authority, or local authority for their respective purposes (b) an ambulance (c) a vehicle used by an Undertaker as defined in Part III of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (d) a vehicle authorised in particular circumstances or for particular purposes by a police constable, a civil enforcement officer, a police community support officer, an official steward or marshal under the direction of the event organisers or (e) a vehicle which displays in a conspicuous position a written authorisation given by North Somerset Council or event organisers.

This shall come into force on **10 May 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months for the temporary prohibition of use by vehicles and the temporary waiting and loading restrictions. However, the restrictions may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the event which is anticipated to be **3 days** in duration (from 4pm on Friday 10 May 2019 until 6pm on Sunday 12 May 2019). Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.
