Election of Parish Councillors for Loxton Parish Council

1. ELECTION

An Election is to be held for four vacancies for Parish Councillors for the above Parish.

2. NOMINATION PAPERS

Nomination papers may be obtained from the Kirsten Griffiths, Clerk to Loxton Parish Council, or from the Returning Officer at the Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, Somerset, BS23 1UJ who will, at the request of an elector, prepare a nomination paper for signature.

3. DELIVERY OF THE NOMINATION PAPERS

Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, Somerset, BS23 1UJ on any day after the date of this notice dated Wednesday, 8th May 2019 on Monday to Friday 10am to 4pm (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4 pm on Wednesday, 16th May 2019.

4. POLL

If the election is contested, a poll will take place on **Thursday, 13th June 2019**.

5. APPLICATIONS TO REGISTER

Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 28th May 2019. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.

6. ABSENT VOTES

Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, Somerset, BS23 1UJ by 5pm on Wednesday, 29th May 2019.

New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, Somerset, BS23 1UJ by 5pm on Wednesday, 5th June 2019.

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, Somerset, BS23 1UJ by 5pm on Thursday, 13th June 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 5st June 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday, 5th June 2019.
