Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Smith & Brenson to undertake structural building works. This will become operative on **10 June 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **4 days** in duration between 9am and 3pm. (Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Exceeding 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross
Weight) Order 2019**

Notice is hereby given that on 17 May 2019 North Somerset Council made an order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the effect of which was to prohibit any vehicle exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight to enter or proceed in the length of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The order comes into operation on **20 May 2019** and a copy thereof together with a map and a copy of the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the order may be inspected at the Highways and Transport Department, Castlewood, Tickenham Road, Clevedon BS21 6FW (callers should report to Reception and ask for the Highways Section) during normal office hours. Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in the order on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within **6 weeks** after the date on which the order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
