Temporary Prohibition of Use by Pedestrians Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to pedestrians the lengths of public right of way specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for works access.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Wessex Water to undertake flood alleviation works. This will become operative on **27 May 2019** for a maximum period of 6 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **66 days** in duration. Appropriate signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Bristol Water to repair leaking main. This will become operative on **28 May 2019** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **3 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.
